- All matches will be fired using the 2016 Smallbore and NRA Precision Air Rifle Rules.
 Scores to be fired in shoulder to shoulder match during regular season.

The individual shooters on the Sectional Air Rifle Teams will be chosen on the basis of two criteria: 1) the individual's year air rifle average (3P and 30 shot Standing) and 2) the sectional total score. The average will be weighed 2/3 and the sectional score 1/3. The individual's year average must consist of at least 5 shoulder to shoulder matches in 3-P Air and 4 matches in 30 shot standing.
