Officials ratings Criteria

Scale of 1-10 – (10 being a great official) 2 points in each of the following categories

Professionalism – shows up on time, interacts with coach/supervisors, is prepared to do his job

Appearance – proper uniform, well groomed, well conditioned

Positioning – knows where and how to move on the court, looks off the ball, quick in transition

Communication – talks and listens to players/coaches when appropriate, diffuses situations on the court before they happen, interacts well with his partner

Game Management – understands time and score situations, particularly near the end of games, aware of game and shot clock, not influenced by crowd or coaches.
