Tapestry - 4x100 Meter Relay Team, Division II

The 4x100 Meter Relay team of Kim Bostic, Mirielle Ngoopos, Taylor Hunter, and Nia Stevens continued their run of greatness winning another Division II State Championship. That's three years in a row for Tapestry and for Taylor and Nia as Division II 4x100m State Champions. The girls ran a personal best time of 48.42, which was only three one-hundredths of a second off their Division II State record of 48.39. They were also the only small school to qualify to compete in the 4x100M Federation Championship. They finished as the 7th fastest team in New York State. The girls also competed in the 4x400M Relay for the second year in a row and finished 10th overall in Division II. This was another incredible year for these amazing young women.

Nia Stevens - 200 Meter Dash, Tapestry, Division II



Nia Stevens continued to make history again in 2017. The sophomore obtained her second straight individual State Championship by winning the 200M with a time of 24.95. She was the only Division II athlete to run a 24 second 200M and she did it on both Friday and Saturday of the Championships. She went into States ranked #1 in Division II and never let up once she got there. In Federation Finals, she finished as the third fastest 200M runner

in New York State and again ran 24.95. Nia also competed in the 100M finishing 3rd overall in Division II. All in all, Nia came home with 5 medals; Division II 200M State Champion, 200M Federation Finals 3rd overall, Division II 4x100M State Champion, 4x100M Relay Federation Finals 7th overall, Division II 100M 3rd overall. In the past three years competing at the State Meet, Nia's collected a total of 12 medals!

The Sweet Home 4x100 Meter Relay Team won the NYSPHSAA title and the NYS Federation Title. The team ran 41.36 in the NYSPHSAA final, which is the 7th fastest time in state history and then ran 41.61 in the Federation Final the next day. The team is comprised of four Juniors, Anthony Williams, who ran leadoff to Eric Johnson, to Thomas Rivera to anchor Nathaniel Davis.



The team is the 1st Section VI team to win the State Title in this event. Also, anchor Nathaniel Davis won the Federation Title in the 200 meters, and earlier in the year equaled the Section VI record of 21.34.

Anton Kunnas - Pole Vault, North Tonawanda, Division I

Anton Kunnas is a Finnish foreign exchange student who led one of the most successful pole vaulting seasons in the history of Section VI. He consistently scored points for his team both on the runway and on the track throughout the season. In his last three meets as an American student, Anton won a Section VI title, a Federation State Championship, and placed tenth at High School New Balance Outdoor Nationals. His accolades on the runway were spectacular, but those who competed with him may better remember him for his sportsmanship and outgoing but humble personality.

Paul Kemsley - Discus, Lancaster, Division I

Paul Kemsley finished his high school career as Discus State Champion. His winning throw in the Discus was 24' better than the second place finisher. In 18 years of coaching, this is the most dominating victory I've seen in the Discus. Paul's throw of 180' 0" is the second best in Lancaster school history and all-time top 5 in Section VI. This accomplishment is all the more incredible given the fact that Paul only threw the Discus 112' as a junior. Paul now moves on to Alfred State University to throw there.
