4.0 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

4.1 Football Alignments/BEDS

The BEDS process with the SED will follow last year's model. The receipt of BEDS numbers are anticipated in late January. Consequently, flexibility will be given regarding the deadline for combining of schools in football. In addition, football schedules will be created later than usual.

4.2 Boys Tennis Appeal

An appeals hearing was held Tuesday, January 8, 2013 regarding a boy's tennis athlete that walked off the court during the 2012 sectional semi-finals. During the hearing, flaws were discovered within the Section VI Boys Tennis Handbook and Section VI Commitment to Compete form. As a result, the Appeals Committee asked the Section VI Boys Tennis Chairman (T. McMahon) to revise the penalty. A 3 game league suspension was then recommended. In addition, the Section VI Commitment to Compete form will be revised. The member school involved will be informed tomorrow, January 17, 2013 of the decision.

4.3 Boys Ice Hockey Suspension

Canisius' boys ice hockey coach was given 2 game misconducts. In accordance with Section VI policy, the coach was suspended for the remainder of the year. Section VI received a legal letter pertaining to the issue, wherein only the coach was named, not Canisius. The Discipline and Rules Committee reviewed the suspension and upheld the decision. A letter has been sent to Canisius, but no response has been given at present. Litigation is not anticipated.

4.4 Wrestling Grievance

The Section is at a level 3 grievance with the NFWOA pertaining to official's fees for wrestling dual meet tournaments. Adam Stoltman was named as Section VI representative. Chris Hope and Dan Hanley were named as NFWOA representatives. Dave Hoover, Director of Labor Relations/School Attorney at Erie 1 BOCES, was chosen by the NFWOA as the third party representative. According to the Section VI 2010-2013 officials' contract –"If an official is given multiple assignments at one site, the fee is full for the highest level contest and 2/3 for the second and subsequent assignments rounded up to the nearest dollar, unless a specific fee already appears in the schedule". NFWOA contests that each varsity match fee is \$86. A meeting is scheduled tomorrow, January 17th, 2013, at which D. Hoover will make a ruling.

4.5 Softball Sectional Finals Venue

The softball committee recommended Sunshine Park (West Seneca) as the venue for all classes in the 2013 sectional finals. Concern was expressed regarding the C and D classes. Jamestown offered to host the C and D classes, which resolves the issue. A north/south venue was proposed as a solution for all sports. T. Slade to review the possibility with all sports' chairs.

4.6 BLAX/GLAX Sectional Finals

The boys and girls lacrosse sectional finals' venue originally conflicted, but the boys committee has since changed their date - resolving the issue.

4.7 Football Pilot Program

K. Stoldt, Section VI football chairman, will meet via conference call with the executive committee at the February 13, 2013 meeting regarding the football scouting pilot program. The football committee is requesting payment by the Section for the \$3200 bill that was incurred.

Note: K. Stoldt received a corporate sponsor from Connors & Ferris in the amount of \$5000 and asked if those funds could be used to pay for the t-shirts the athletes receive at Ralph Wilson instead of member schools incurring the cost. If those monies were not used for t-shirts, they would have been used for the pilot program. Discussion: The Section will not fund the program for following years, but will assist in the coordination with Erie 1 BOCES as it may be aidable. Divisional chairman will decide if the pilot was successful and make a recommendation for the future.

4.8 Wrestling Litigation

Section VI is involved in an ongoing lawsuit regarding a student athlete from Iroquois accused of participating in a wrestling tournament while having an active case of herpes gladitorium. T. Slade has been called to give deposition representing Section VI. Note: There is no requirement to have a physician on sight, although Section VI does provide one. The deposition will take place within the next month. T. Slade to update as the process moves forward.

4.9 Negotiations Update

Three meetings have been conducted thus far regarding the officials' contract. The committees are set to reconvene in February 2013. A recommendation for the athletic council is anticipated before the end of the school year.
