#### 4.0 **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

#### 4.1 Seeding Policy

Concern was expressed pertaining to the terminology used in the policy manual regarding the seeding policy. Currently, the seeding policy refers to "league" games. An action item will be added to the January athletic council meeting requesting that the policy be altered to include the terms "league/division" games. The need for this request stems from the fact that coaches in the ECIC and CCAA are counting all matches, including those contests that fall outside of division play.

### 4.2 WNYSO Contract Update

Payment, minutes, and all other pertinent information was sent to the state office to begin the Fact Finding process. R. Stulmaker, NYSPHSAA Assistant Director, to update T. Slade as the process moves forward.

### 4.3 Section VI Wall of Fame Update

J. Dunnigan, chairman and B. Banker, assistant chairman of the Section VI Wall of Fame committee, began the planning process for the 1<sup>st</sup> Section VI Wall of Fame induction ceremony. They are modeling the nomination application after the state association's application. The 2014 Football Championships at Ralph Wilson Stadium have been chosen as the venue to recognize the selected candidates. T. Slade to e-mail each league requesting a representative to sit on the wall of fame committee. Deadline dates for receipt of nomination applications and candidate selections will be announced during a future meeting.

### 4.4 Wrestling Litigation Update

T. Slade to be deposed in March 2014 regarding the lawsuit pertaining to the Starpoint class wrestling tournament where a student athlete contracted herpes gladitorium. T. Slade to update as the process moves forward.

### 4.5 Disability Insurance/Compensation Update

As per the requirement of The New York State Insurance Fund, Section VI purchased an insurance policy for Section VI sports chairpersons as they are considered employees of the Section. Currently, there are two audits being conducted with Section VI, one with worker's compensation and one with disability insurance to ensure all Section affairs regarding insurance are in order.

### 4.6 Sport Chairperson Face-to-Face State Meetings

The state association recently approved face-to-face meetings for state chairpersons and their committees. As a result, Section VI sports chairpersons are now required to attend state face-to-face meetings.

The state association will absorb the travel expenses of section chairpersons to attend these meetings. As a result, Section VI representatives expressed their concern regarding the impression of partiality between fiscal concerns.

Note: The state association will only pay for one travel reimbursement. For example, if boys and girls soccer meetings are scheduled together, the boys and girls chairmen must travel together.

### 4.7 Boys Volleyball Semi-Final Change

Section VI was unable to secure Lakeshore High School or Cleveland Hill High School as the boys volleyball semi-final venue in place of Orchard Park HS. As a result, T. Slade made the decision to hold the contests at the higher seed.

### 4.8 Sectional Scheduling

Concern was expressed regarding post season scheduling conflicts (ie: Boys & Girls AA Soccer playing on the same day at venues 2 hours away from one another). It is impossible to avoid all conflicts, but T. Slade will meet with sport chairpersons to review the scheduling process to avoid potential conflicts.

### 4.9 Combining of Schools End of Season Report

- a) As a result of the new combining of schools formula, the combining of schools end of season report was re-instituted. Host schools of a combined team, are asked to submit this report at the end of the season. Currently, there are 144 schools in 75 combined teams within Section VI.
- b) In addition, flexibility will be given regarding the timeline for the submission of combining of schools applications when schedules for the sport involved are **not** affected.

#### 5.0 Classification Committee

R. Zayas, NYSPHSAA Executive Director, was directed to establish a classification committee. Classification numbers have changed, where teams may be significantly impacted regarding season performance outcomes. P. Burke was chosen as the Section VI representative to sit on this committee.
