**Report on changes in Policy or Practice that were implemented**

Range Finders were allowed as per USGA Guidelines for both the Sectional Qualifier and States. No problems were reported at both levels. Please see Boy's Golf Handbook for more specific information regarding range finders.

**Problems encountered/ concerns**

The State Golf Committee is very concerned that decisions are being made about Boy's Golf without either the State Boy's Golf Chairman and/or Committee being consulted. We are in direct contact with the coaches, players and parents and have a very good understanding of how these decisions impact the experience of the players, coaches and parents have at our championships.

Examples:

Both the Section VI Boy's Golf Committee as well as the NYSPHSAA State Golf Committee are concerned about the discontinuation of team uniforms for 2014, even if districts or our Section does not pay for them. Both committees feel that teams should be allowed to wear uniforms provided the funds do not come from the schools or section.

Both committees unanimously support the continuation of the Boy's Golf State Championship at Cornell University.

The State Golf Committee does not support the discontinuation of bag tags and state shirts.

The State Golf Committee does not support the decision to prevent coaches from playing practice rounds with or behind their players. We have not yet heard a plausible rationale for this decision and all others for that matter. We are simply asking to be heard as a committee.

**Report on changes in Policy or Practice that were implemented: NA**

**Tournament report / concerns**

- The sectional tournament was a relatively smooth tournament this year. The only issue was the weather, which became a factor during finals week.
- Jamestown agreed to host the Cs and Ds, and was an excellent site. We are very appreciative of Ben Drake and the grounds crew of Jamestown for all the work they did to make sure a field was playable for the final games.
- On the day before the A and B finals, the town of West Seneca received well over an inch of rain. The grounds crew at Sunshine Park did a remarkable job in making sure that the fields were ready for the finals that night.
- One issue that arose at West Seneca was that the Town Attorney called Mr. Slade and informed him that the Section could not charge admission for the finals due to a local law of which we were unaware. Other town facilities in West Seneca had hosted and charged before (West Seneca Soccer Complex), so if the committee decides to use this park again for finals, it is important to research what steps needed to be done to charge for admission at this venue.
- The Class A crossover game and Class AA final were completed on the Saturday of tournament week. The Class B crossover game made it midway through the third inning, and then the skies opened up. The game was ultimately suspended. Unfortunately, West Seneca could not get a field ready on that Sunday, so the game was moved to the following Monday. Thankfully, Dunkirk High School volunteered to host the game, as it had a great, (and dry!) playing field, and was equidistant from both schools. The tournament was completed that Monday. Many thanks to Al Gens, John Sliwa, and the grounds crew at Dunkirk for their help.

**Recommendations for next season**

- The Cs and Ds in the Southern Tier were extremely well attended. I recommend keeping those games in that area, perhaps on a different day from the other final games.
- If the admission issue cannot be resolved, I would recommend finding a different site in the northern area to host finals. We are in preliminary discussions with the Northtown Center (Pepsi Center) in Amherst, and they WANT to host sectionals next year. They have already given us a plan to accommodate charging admission, and would welcome the concession revenue for their own organization.

**POST SEASON CALENDAR: There is a proposal by baseball and softball to change the date of the state tournament due to the late graduation date in June, as well as the June 3, 2014 administration of the new Common Core Algebra and ELA exams. Therefore, since we do not know the date of finals, we cannot make a post season schedule at this point.**

**Report on changes in Policy or Practice that were implemented**

Coaches were asked to email state standard qualifiers prior to sectionals – much better but still a few schools that did not adhere to deadlines. We stayed in two different hotels – right next to each other – boys in one – girls in the other. This worked out very well.

**Problems encountered/concerns**

Late entries for Sectionals is still a concern – but much better than in the past – late opt out papers for States continues to be a problem. Originally we were supposed to have 3 – 55 person busses – informed less than three days to departure one was only a 44 person bus – we had to do some scrambling to our bus list and each bus had no extra room. If a couple of athletes had not opted out we would have been in trouble. We also had a problem with one of the busses at departure that has very poor front tires. The bus was required to replace the tires prior to departing for the State Meet. The State Meet at Middletown was rained out on day one – we completed the entire meet in one day on Sat. - Athletes and Coaches did a fantastic job with the adjustments to the delay and time schedules.

**Recommendations for next season including proposed dates**

Continue to impress upon coaches of deadlines and strict adherence to those deadlines. Discuss possible changes to entry system – posting qualifying list more than once. Recommend going with another bus company.
