5). NFHS Rules/Official's Concerns:

- NFHS FH 2016 rules were not released prior to this meeting.
- Discussion of officials using headsets.....we cannot mandate uses of headset during state championships, since all sections do not use them during the regular season.
- Ask the officials which headsets are better. (Bluetooth headsets hear everything around them.)
- The Field Hockey Committee would like to have all playoff officials to have knowledge and use of headsets so they can be used at playoff tournaments when possible.
- *Officials Organization* is working on getting more Field Hockey Officials. *Todd Nelson* discussed plans to recruit new officials.
- Field Hockey Committee request the Officials Organization help work for consistency/interpretation in calls for all sections, especially prior to playoffs. For all rules but specifically: aerial balls, reverse stick chip shot and advance 10/green card interpretation

6). Section Concerns:

ALL SECTIONS ARE CONCERNED ABOUT THE NUMBER OF OFFICIALS AVAILABLE.

- Section 1- Decrease in JV teams and concern for Modified teams. Todd suggested having 9th graders play with Modified.
- Section 2 problems some programs holding a Varsity program with JV or Modified teams.
 - Concerned about the imbalance of Girls' Fall Sports programs vs other seasons.
- Section 3- Serious concerns about True NYSPHSAA 'D' teams having to play 'C' teams.
- Section 5- plays modified in the Spring, number of players trying out for individual teams is up, concerned about the number of officials.
- Section 8- lost a Varsity team, concerned about the number of officials.
- Section 9-- concerned about the number of officials.
- Sections 4 & 6- no concerns at this time.

7). OTHER BUSINESS:

- Field Hockey Committee members will review the 2015 program and update info. Changes can be done on the website for the program and also through Joe Agostinlli for updates.
- Coordinators check with Max preps for program ads. Items for the program should be submitted ASAP before the Tournament.
- Committee members review and make sure 2016 All-State Player information is correct, send changes to Bev Hooper.
- Section 3 has concerns at the Modified Level regarding the aerial ball as written in the rule book, asking for input from the Field Hockey Committee.
- The Field Hockey Committee states that the NFHS Field Hockey Rule book should be followed with appropriate applications for players at all levels.
- Classification numbers for 2016 will be released after the January 29th executive meeting. SECTION 3 requested that the Field Hockey Committee review classification numbers used for our sport giving consideration to the smaller schools. Once the 2016 Classification numbers are released (Jan 29th) the Field Hockey Committee will have a conference call to review possible changes.
