- 4.2 Hall of Fame Golf Tournament Sponsorships Update
  - T. Slade is in the process of confirming individuals for the North and South regions of Section VI (an individual for the Central region is confirmed) to solicit sponsors for the Hall of Fame Golf Tournament and induction ceremony.

The Hall of Fame sponsorship sales position format is as follows:

As directed by the Executive Committee at the March 22, 2017 meeting, three individuals (North, Central, South) will be hired, at no cost to the Section, to solicit sponsors for the Hall of Fame Golf Tournament and induction ceremony. The following format will be used for the compensation of their services.

\$0 - \$999 - 10% Commission

\$1,000 - \$1,499 - 12% Commission

\$1.500 - Above - 15% Commission

The proceeds from the HOF Golf Tournament will be split 50/50 (50% Crohns Colitis Foundation/50% Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony (plaques, awards, program, facility rental etc.). Each year, Section VI will choose a different foundation to make a 50% proceed donation.

#### 4.3 Football Officiating Assignments

Representatives of the Western New York Certified Football Officials (WNYCFO) notified Section VI of their concerns regarding an anticipated shortage of officials in relation to the increase in the number of Friday night games scheduled. With the exception of week 8, K. Stoldt, Football Chairman, believes the makeup of the schedule will not result in football official coverage issues.

#### 4.4 BOCES Superintendent Vacancy

As stated in the Section VI Constitution, one superintendent representative from each BOCES (Erie 1, Erie 2, Orleans Niagara, and Cattaraugus Allegany) will be a member of the Section VI Athletic Council. The Section VI Executive Committee will recommend individuals for vacant superintendent representative positions to the district superintendent. However, the selection of the candidate is entirely at the discretion of the district superintendent.

#### 4.5 Group 05/WNYUA Letter of Protest

Section VI received a copy of a letter issued by G. Neunder, WNYUA President, to John Sherman, Erie 1 BOCES Board President, protesting the inclusion of and process by which #14 of the officials contract was negotiated. A copy of this letter was sent to the NYSPHSAA office and Central Committee members.

#14. No official should be required to give an assigner/sub-assigner a percentage of his/her wages in order to receive high school or modified level contests regardless of what an organization's constitution or by-laws state.

• Combining of Schools Formula Proposal

The current graduated scale for combining of teams is as follows: Class AA - 50%, Class A – 40%, Class B – 30%, Class C – 30%, Class D – 20%. The Combining of Teams Committee formula adjustment proposal will be a discussion item at the May 2017 NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting. The proposal is as follows:

Class AA – 100%, Class A – 100%, Class B – 100%, Class C – 40%, and Class D - 30%. In addition, if 4 or more teams in team sports combine, 100% of the BEDS would be taken of all 4 schools.

Section VI does not fully support the Combining of Schools Formula Proposal. M. Fallacaro, Section VI Girls Representative, will seek to alter the proposed percentage for Class B from 100% to 50% of the BEDS at the May 2017 NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting.
