Items Discussion/ Action Taken:

- 1) Committee Directory reviewed and made changes to committee directory.
- 2) Discussion re: Use of Two Sites/Fields for 2016 Tournament(Vestal/Maine-Endwell)

NYSPHSAA will address vendors at both sites for future

Two Sites/Fields were ideal for players, not having to play games starting after 7:30 pm Use of Heaters will NOT be allowed at team bench area

- 3) NYSPHSAA Section Reports- (Lack of Officials is a problem in all sections.)
 - Sect 1: decrease in JV Teams, concern about imbalance of Girls Fall Sports effecting programs
 - Sect 2: Lack of Officials, concern about imbalance of Girls Fall Sport impacting programs
 - Sect 3: Concern with aerial play consistency, self start is an issue, they have two Officials' Boards in their Section-conflict of interpretation.

- NYS Officials meeting:
 - 1. Officials were asked to use hand signals even though they are using radios to communicate.
 - 2. Trying to get more officials to use the radios. Officials are looking at radios to connect to all 3 officials who are working the game.
 - 3. There are 388 rated umpires in NYS for 2016.
