1.0 Sports Concerns:

1.1 Boys Volleyball – Spring Season Update (Appendix A)

Long Island has made a proposal at the state level to move Boys Volleyball to the spring season. The Section VI Boys Volleyball Committee is opposed to this proposal. It was noted that all other sections, with the exception of Long Island, are also opposed to this proposal. This item will be acted on at the January 18, 2023 athletic council meeting, requesting approval to direct M. Fallacaro-Dougherty, Female Representative, and J. Roth, Male Representative to oppose this proposal at the state level.

1.2 Boys Volleyball – Consideration to move ECIC to a confederation

This item is a proposal on the Boys Volleyball post season report. However, due to a lack of information within this proposal, it was changed to a concern. Sectional Intersectional committee members were asked to discuss this item with their respective leagues and be prepared to provide report at the February 9 Sectional Intersectional meeting.

1.2 Rifle – Section VI Sports Standards

Rifle is no longer a New York State sponsored sport. Therefore, there are no standards in the NYSPHSAA handbook. Committee members were reminded that 5 participating sections with 5 or more schools are needed in order to have a state championship.

The Section VI Rifle Chairperson took the last published NYSPHSAA handbook rifle standards and used them for the 2022-23 Section VI Rifle Handbook.

*It was noted that Rifle is not listed in the Section VI Constitution nor Policy Manual as a Section VI sport. It has always been considered an ECIC sport even though Kenmore is a participating school.

Recommendation to move the Rifle Sport Standards to the January 18, 2023 athletic council meeting for formal approval.

1.3 Flag Football Proposal (Appendix B)

B. Drake was asked to confirm the CCAA Division wishes to run as a pilot in their own division for the 2023 season and not participate in Section VI playoffs and that Dunkirk has elected to participate in the Section VI divisions. Also, concern was expressed about implementing 16 regular season games. S/I Committee members were asked to have their respective league presidents reach out to their league Flag Football representatives and discuss these concerns prior to the Athletic Council meeting next Wednesday, January 18.

This item was tabled for further discussion.

1.4 St. Mary's Flag Football

St. Mary's asked to be included in the Section VI Flag Football schedule. The Sectional Intersectional Committee unanimously opposed this request. However, member schools, if inclined, can schedule non-league games with St. Mary's.

1.5 Unified Basketball – 2 Philosophies – Sect/Int to report on direction from leagues

Offering competitive and non-competitive programs were suggested, but this option would pose issues with travel. S/I Committee members were asked to discuss this option with their respective leagues and be prepared to report back and formulate a recommendation at the February 9th Sectional Intersectional Committee meeting.

1.6 Boys Tennis 2023 Individual State Tournament – Dates Changed to June 2nd, 3rd, and 4th

This is informational only. The change was made due to a conflict with regents exams. This will be reported at January 18th, 2023 Athletic Council meeting. The Boys Tennis Chairman and league heads were notified.

1.7 Fall 2022 Post Season Reports (Appendix C)

1.7.1 Concerns

a) Boys Soccer - Concern with boys postseason contests; lopsided games

The committee felt that trying to manage or control the number of goals scored is not possible.

b) Girls Soccer

- "Newfane" was removed from post season due to violating the NYSPHSAA number of contests (17 games played) and only 16 are permitted.
- There was an incorrect seeding with Southwestern for the 2022 season. Southwestern should have been the 8th seed hosting Falconer. The Girls Soccer Committee incorrectly calculated Southwestern as the 9th seed playing at Falconer. The Section VI Policy Handbook states that once seeding is calculated and brackets set, changes are not allowed. S/I Committee members were asked to remind their respective leagues' sport committee chairs to review the calculations prior to the seeding meeting to ensure accuracy and avoid future issues.

c) Girls Volleyball – No concerns.

d) Field Hockey – No concerns.

e) Football

- The 2023 start date is Saturday, Aug. 20. Football will always start the Saturday prior to the Monday start date for all fall sports.
- Allegany-Limestone and Frewsburg have 8-man programs and participate in Section V.

Recommendation to move the 2023 football proposed alignments proposal forward to the athletic council for approval.

f) Girls Gymnastics – The chairman reported concerns about males not being able to participate in post season competition.

g) Girls Swimming – see agenda item 1.7.2c,d and e

h) Cross Country – The Cross Country Committee is interested in utilizing Elma Meadows for sectionals. Alden has been used in the recent past. Elma Meadows was previously used until issues arose with Erie County regarding insurance liability. M. DiFilippo to investigate if Elma Meadows is an option.

i) Girls Tennis – concern was expressed about the high number of schools opting out for team sectionals.

Recommendation to move the Fall 2022 sport post season reports with the exceptions as noted to the athletic council for approval.

1.7.2 Proposals

a) Boys Volleyball - Proposal to Change Power Point Tie Breakers

With the forthcoming implementation of 6 classifications, beginning with the 2023-24 school year, M. DiFilippo would like to review the procedures for all sports. S/I Committee members were asked to discuss with their respective leagues the option to allow for sport specific nuances and seeding procedures or to keep standard universal procedures for all sports. In lieu of a regular S/I Committee meeting, the February 9th meeting will be an in-person meeting used to discuss how the Section wants to move forward.

The Boys Volleyball Power Point Tie Breakers proposal is tabled and the scheduled February 9th S/I meeting will be used to discuss power points and seeding for all sports.

b) Boys Volleyball – Proposal to read the Sportsmanship Pledge at all matches

Recommendation to charge the leagues with the policing of reading the Sportsmanship Pledge at all Boys Volleyball matches

- c) Girls Swimming – Proposal to implement cross league competition beginning 2023
The NO League swims both Boys and Girls in the winter season. The NFL only swims once a week. This proposal would affect the BPS, CCAA, and ECIC.
The Cross League Competition Proposal is tabled for further clarification by the Girls Swimming Committee.
- d) Girls Swimming – Proposal to increase Thursday evening dual meet competitions
The proposal to increase Thursday evening competitions is tabled for further clarification by the Girls Swimming Committee.
- e) Girls Swimming – Proposal 2023 Schedule
The proposed 2023 Schedule is tabled for further clarification by the Girls Swimming Committee.

2.0 Section Concerns:

- 2.1 12.3 of Article 12 of the Section VI Constitution (Boys Ice Hockey) – Committee member reports from leagues S/I Committee representatives reported difficulty in obtaining direction on this item. J. Przybysz and J. 

In the Spring 2022 pilot season of Girls Flag Football, 12 teams from Section VI participated in the season. For the 2023 season, we have 27 districts in Section VI that signed up to participate. The proposed divisional alignment is below for review. This proposal is from the Section VI Flag Football Committee.

Season Details - Proposal

Season Start Date: March 13, 2023

League Games: 10-11 depending division

Game Maximum: 16 (pending approval from NYSPHSAA in February)

- Teams may add non-league games if desired. Scheduling not provided by Section VI.
- CCAA Division will run as a pilot this season in their own division and will not participate in Section VI playoffs. Dunkirk has elected to participate in the Section VI divisions.
- Only league games will count toward Sectional Seeding.
- Sectional seeding and tiebreakers will be determined once alignment has been approved.
- The divisions are based on BEDS numbers for the current school year.
- Teams will play once around within their division.

1.) Possible Proposal for Boys Volleyball to move from the ECIC to a Confederation

Twenty coaches voted in our poll. The current vote was 13-7 to federate. However, there were discrepancies in league voting to Confederate. See the league vote below:

This should be a topic to be discussed by AD's and their coaches. It is suggested that each section rep should represent their league's position at the athletic council for discussion and then see if this would be a viable change. It is suggested that if this proposal moves forward for the upcoming year that it be a 2 year trial and then revisited as to its merits.

2.) Sent Vote to State on Possibility to Switch Boys Vball to the Spring Season

I took a vote at the year end Boys Vball Meeting and the coaches overwhelmingly voted to stay as a Fall Sport due to facility problems in the spring, loss of coaches and athletes to other sport commitments, our schools being so much smaller than other parts of the state lowering the possible pool of players, and the interference with USA club volleyball participation.

3.) Proposal to Change Power Point Tie Breakers for WNY Boys Vball

Rational for the change was to eliminate a tie by a coin toss. Remove Divisional wins as a tie breaker because of the differing number of teams in divisions.

We would like to propose ties in Power Points for seeding be as follows...

1. Head-to-head in the division
2. Set percentage head-to-head in division
3. Set percentage in division
4. Point percentage in division
5. Coin flip

4.) A suggestion...That the NYSPHSAA/Section VI Sportsmans Pledge be read at all matches after the Pledge to the Flag...

2022 POST- SEASON REPORT Girls Swimming & Diving December 28, 2022

The Section Committee (*League Chairs and At-Large Members*) met virtually on December 7 to review the season and discuss recommendations for the 2023 season to better prepare the contents of this report

2022-2023 Coaches Sportsmanship Nomination:

The committee unanimously nominated Gavin Christopher Miller, coach of the Williamsville East team for the Coaches Sportsmanship award.

Report on changes in Policy or Practice that were implemented:

- There were no changes to policy or practice exercise during the Fall 2022 season. The season mirrored the traditional pre-COVID format of 2019.

Problems encountered/concerns:

- Problems: There were no problems during the fall 2022 season.
- Concerns:
 - A. The swim committee discussed the season format at length. After extensive research from other sections across the state, it was evident that Section VI has a long standing tradition of competing within the various athletic leagues (BPS, CCAA, ECIC, NFL, and NO,) throughout the regular season. This practice is not common throughout the other sections. The vast majority of teams in the state swim their regular season within their *class* of their Section, rather than leagues. Within Section VI, the post season league meet and/or championship has a history that continues to be supported by their leagues. With that format, there is limited flexibility for post-season competition.
 - B. Many of the leagues would like to increase their number of dual and/or double dual meets due to decrease in meets due to combined schools teams. See Committee proposal 1.
 - C. Committee members discussed that the State Qualifier meet portrays two very different philosophies
 1. a last change opportunity to qualify for the State Championship meet competing against other athletes of similar abilities
 - a. As a coach, I may “stack” my relays then to get 2 or 3 relay teams to the state meet.
 - b. This may potentially sacrifice my fastest swimmers who could also have an opportunity to be crowned Sectional Champion in a second individual event.
 - c. Ultimately, this opens the doors for more athletes to qualify for the state meet and better represent Section VI.

2. a Sectional Championship
 - a. similar format to wrestling, track events, etc.
3. Is there a way to unite and/or accommodate these philosophies?
- D. The committee spoke about which meet has the greatest emphasis -
 1. the Class Championships
 2. the Section State Qualifier meet
 3. With that then, the greater emphasis should have a prelims/finals format.
 4. Regardless, the sequence of meets should progress in both competitiveness and energy.
- E. The Executive Director noted that Individual Sports (Swimming/Diving, Wrestling, Track & Field, etc.) are inconsistent with Championship awards (patches, plaques, etc.).
 1. Nate Bourke will be surveying these sports to see what and where they give out certain awards in an attempt to streamline the process for future seasons.

Other pertinent data:

- Each swim section must submit one official to be the representative of that Section to the NYSPHSAA Championship meet.
- With the state meet being in Webster, NY in 2023, Section VI may have more representatives based upon geography.
- The committee presented four names. Nate will see which, if any of those four, would be interested in being the formal representative.

Report on changes in Policy or Practice that were implemented

Sectional Tournament: The tournament was held at Miller Tennis Center in Williamsville, NY and ran smoothly with no problems. With 8 courts, the tournament is able to be run in less time and more efficiently. Viewing is great at MTC.

Representation from each league broke down as follows:

NFL - 3 singles and 3 doubles

CCAA - 3 singles and 4 doubles

ECIC - 7 singles and 7 doubles

BPS - 3 singles and 2 doubles

*** Due to BPS only able to send 2 representatives for doubles, CCAA sent an extra to fill the bye. A fair rotation will be used if this happens again in the future.

State Individual Tournament: Transportation and meal policy continues to go well. The tournament was held at SPORTIME Schenectady and players stayed at the Crowne Plaza Albany - The Desmond again. The State implemented the format which eliminated the consolation rounds and awarded medals to 1st-8th place. A couple parents voiced their opinion that they still preferred the consolation rounds.

State Team Tournament: Held at the National Tennis Center in NYC on Friday November 5th. Our Division 1 champions, Clarence will represent Section VI this year. Coach Alex Chambers has reported that he is all set and good to go. I will update upon their return with results.

Problems encountered/ concerns/notations

Regular Season –

No problems. Most coaches voiced their concerns that the UTR Score Reporting site was not as beneficial as the former score reporting site of Rick Schneider. Since this is a state mandate, there is not much we can do about it. The change will take some time to get used to.

Individual Sectionals – The tournament ran smoothly. No issues to be reported. BPS only sent 2 reps out of the 3 allotted for doubles. CCAA sent an extra doubles to fill the bye.

Team Sectionals -

42 teams out of 54 opted out of the tournament. Other sections that have been running the tournament for years have almost 100% participation.

- Due to the high number of opt outs, the format was modified and changed a handful of times to accommodate.
- Neutral sites may be considered for the future.
- League Schedulers need to take into consideration the weather when putting together matches and the 6 match requirement to participate in the Team Sectional Tournament.
- Format may be modified to a top 8 Division 1 and top 8 division 2 teams qualify format.

States – Tournament ran smoothly. Start times were given that staggered singles and doubles matches and the use of all 8 courts helped the flow of the tournament.

There was a miscommunication between NYSPHSAA and the hotel and breakfast was NOT included in our stay. We did not find out until about 11pm on Wednesday, the night we arrived. Not much could be done so players had to eat breakfast at the hotel and bill to the chairperson's room. Hopefully, there will be arrangements made for next year as we will be at the same hotel again.

The host hotel was about a 15-25 minutes drive to the courts depending on traffic with tolls each way.

The players seemed to have a blast and represented their schools and Section VI with class. It was a great showing. Players continued to support each other and represent even after they were eliminated from the tournament.

Recommendations for next season & proposed dates

1. We would like to hold our Section 6 tournament on October 13th and 14th, 2023 in the Northtowns. This is still a week earlier than normal in order to make room for the team(s) that will advance to regionals this year. I will be in contact with Todd Miller from MTC shortly. My goal is to provide a venue that can provide an entire block of courts for our tournament. Start times for Friday and Saturday will be 12PM noon and 3PM ideally as they have been in the past.
2. ****The Team Regionals match will be held in Section V on Saturday October 21st, 2023 pending confirmation from Section V.**
3. The State Individual Tournament will again be a Thursday – Saturday tournament to match the boys. It will remain week 17 of the Standard Calendar of Weeks for NYSPHSAA and will be held 10/26-10/28 at SPORTIME Schenectady. The committee will meet again in December 2022 to go over any other details. I intend to secure a block of rooms at Crowne Plaza Albany - The Desmond.
4. The State Team Tournament will be held November 3rd, 2023 at the National Tennis Center in NYC.
5. The dates/locations for the Section VI Team Sectional Tournament would ideally be held on Saturday September 23rd(Round 1), Tuesday September 26th(Quarterfinals) and Saturday October 7th(Semis/Finals). Winning Division 1 and Division 2 teams will play against Section V on Saturday October 21st in Section V. If we change the format to top 8 teams, we may eliminate the first date.
