1.0 Sports Concerns:

1.1 Boys and Girls Basketball 2-Year Tiebreaker Pilot (approved AC Sept 2022) ends this year

*The Pilot deviates from the Section Policy Manual. If Boys Basketball and Girls Basketball want to move forward after 2 years, a proposal would have to be made to change the Policy Manual.

Concern was expressed as, currently, some sports' tiebreaker procedures deviate from the Policy Manual. The Boys and Girls Basketball 2-year pilot ends with the conclusion of this winter 23-24 season and the Section has three (3) other sports in the process of requesting changes in their tiebreaker procedure.

The consensus of the S/I Committee is to create a framework regarding tiebreakers across all sports, but to allow the sports committees the autonomy to generate and present proposals they feel fit the needs of their sports. The framework will include the proposal process and the hierarchy of review, recommendation, and determination as well as piloting implementation and analysis if deemed approved. In addition, the framework will include a mandatory pilot period, but permit sports to revert to past practice if the change enacted is not proving beneficial as originally anticipated. The Policy Manual will be revised to include this framework to provide a clear explanation of the tiebreaker procedure for all to reference and/or follow.

M. DiFilippo to request that Boys/Girls Basketball provide their recommendation regarding their ending tiebreaker pilot within their 2023-2024 post season report

A section for current pilots and proposals will be added to pre and post season reports.

1.2 Boys and Girls Soccer semi-finals

The NO League has not had a chance to discuss this item as a group at present. The CCAA, NFL, ECIC and BPS are in favor of having the semi-finals move to the higher seed, but regardless of the decision for boys and girls to have the same procedure.

Recommendation to move boys and girls soccer semi-finals to higher seeds CARRIED

 - -The Boys Soccer committee indicates interest in piloting splitting classes after the opt out date (this was already approved via the March 20, 2024 athletic council meeting for both boys and girls for 24-25 and 25-26)
 - -The Boys Committee making recommendation that a maximum of 5 non-player personnel allowed in the bench area and plans to add to the handbook.
 - The S/I Committee expressed concern about policing of this proposal and remaining consistent across all sports. This is believed to be more of a sectional issue, but it is not clear if it is it is specific to only post season.
 - * The S/I Committee felt further discussion is required. Therefore, this proposal is excused from the request for approval of this report at the May 2024 athletic council meeting.

g) Girls Swimming

The Girls Swimming Committee is proposing to use 100% of beds for any combined swim teams. The chairperson shared that the intent is to recommend this practice for both boys and girls. This only affects class meets as there is only 1 classification at the state level. The only 3 sports that deviate from the state procedure are Boys and Girls Swimm and Indoor Track. This proposal would allow for Section VI to follow state procedure in these 3 sports, which is consistent with all other sports.

The S/I Committee will review this proposal for all 3 sports with their respective leagues before making recommendation.

This proposal is excused from the request for approval of this report at the May 2024 athletic council meeting.

M. DiFilippo to inquire with Indoor Track chairperson about following suit with this proposal.

h) Girls Field Hockey (Marisa)

No concerns. The combined team of Holland and East aurora will move to class B for the 2024 season.

i) Girls Tennis (Ben)

It was noted that Section 6 has the lowest number of teams participating in sectional team championships across the state.

This will have very minimal impact on classification organization.

The Committee also recognizes that BEDS numbers do not always correlate to a team's strength and performance. Therefore, utilizing crossover meet opportunities again this fall, based on 2023 results, will help to strengthen competition and build programs.

<u>Sectional 6 Classification Championship Meets</u> / <u>State Qualifier Meet</u> The format used for Class championships hosted by member schools as a three-day format (swim prelims, diving, swim finals) worked well in the 2022 and 2023 seasons.. A timed final state qualifier meet held at a college facility, recognizing the fastest swimmer/top diver within the section. Both the boys and girls committees

Of Special Note:

- 1. We continue to have the lowest % of teams participating in Team Sectionals across the State. (15 in 2023)
- 2. Teams need to make sure that they have scheduled enough matches for players to be eligible. They need to have played 6 matches in order to be eligible for sectional play.
- 3. We will again use a top 8 format for each division because of low participation with teams from each league being represented fairly. The committee would like some flexibility in case more or less teams choose to participate.
- 4. Clarification of practice/line-up rules will again be made prior to the tournament.
- In the Section VI Team Championship tournament, we will use the following format to match the format at the state level.
 - Division 1 3 singles and 4 doubles (11 players) If you do not have enough players to field all positions, you
 will forfeit at that position.
 - Division 2 2 singles and 3 doubles (8 players) *Format is part of a 2-year pilot that will be used for 2024 and 2025. *****

Team Sectionals

Day 1 - Saturday September 28th: Quarterfinals and Semifinals

8 Team Bracket - Single elimination Draw

This will be a regular scoring, best 2 out of 3 set matches.

Seeds will be based on team record up until Sept. 20th, BEDS, perceived strength according to chairpersons, and may consist of UTR, past performances, or other information available at that time. The goal is to have a fair and equitable tournament for all teams in order to send our strongest team to Regionals.

Once a site is determined (Division 1 must be at a site with 8 courts if at all possible), a schedule of time will be made available.

Day 2 - Tuesday October 8th: Finals

This will be a regular scoring, best 2 out of 3 set match using the format listed above.

The winners will advance to Regionals vs. Section V during the week of October 21st.

In case of rain, we will use the next available day to get the matches in. In some cases, we may need to use a Sunday, or more sites/multiple days.

Sectional Championship matches will take precedence over league matches.

Changes in Policy/Practice for the upcoming season

For the Individual Sectionals each league will send reps as follows:

ECIC (7), NFL (3), CCAA (3), Buffalo (3). If Buffalo again does not send a full field, the next highest seeded players amongst the CCAA, NFL and ECIC (as agreed upon by the committee) will fill in the brackets.

The Executive Committee approved a 2 singles/3 doubles format for Division 2 NYSPHSAA Team Championships as a two-year pilot which will be used in the 2024 and 2025 girls' team championships. Therefore, in the postseason - we will use that same format for Division 2 Team Sectional Tournament as well as the Section VI vs Section V regional match.

For the 2024 NYSPHSAA Individual Tournament, Section 6 will send 3 singles qualifiers and 4 doubles teams.

NYSPHSAA has received an offer by Diadem for a five-year agreement to provide all the tennis balls for the state tournaments (individual & team) and sectional level tournaments. These tennis balls are USTA and ITF approved for tournament play. This is not a done deal.

Rule Changes for 2024-2025:

We will follow the most up-to-date safety information and protocols (if any) regarding Covid-19.

Other Pertinent Data

- A joint proposal for boys and girls tennis was approved which states that all NYSPHSAA tennis players are required to claim their profile in the Universal Tennis Rating (UTR) system prior to the season. Coaches/schools are also required to claim their teams and update their rosters. This provides NYSPHSAA and member sections a comprehensive system to properly seed its tournaments..
- 2. Coaches will be required to report scores using the UTR website as our official score reporting site. This is free and step by step instructions will be given. The UTR is the most important number when it comes to seeding players at the State level and for many sections, at the section level as well.
- 3. We will hold our <u>Section 6 individual tournament</u> at the Lakewood YMCA. The club has already committed to hosting the event and has agreed to the proposed tentative start times. They have agreed to 5 courts on Friday and 4 courts on Saturday.
- 4. Section VI will be hosting the Section VI vs. Section V Regional matches this year on the week of October 21st and a location to be determined as well as times.
- 5. The <u>Individual State tournament</u> will be held <u>Monday October 28th to Wednesday October 30th</u>, at the <u>USTA National Tennis Center in Flushing, NY.</u> I am awaiting more info to confirm on a block of 10 rooms

at a host hotel.

- <u>6.</u> The transportation/meal/hotel policy has worked out very well for years now and I would again recommend continuing with this policy.
- 7. The State committee seeding meeting at the State Tournament will be held on Sunday October 27th.
