 - 4.1 NYS ball adoption agreement

The Executive Committee supports M. DiFilippo and M. Donahue signing the NYSPHSAA ball adoption agreement for the 2024-2025 through 2028-2029 term. The agreement contracts with Spalding. If all 11 sections in NYS opt-in, Section VI will receive \$33,401 in annual revenue share as well as \$2797 in product and an allotment of balls, which are distributed to our sports chairs for sectional play at neutral sites. The NYSPHSAA ball adoption agreement is an action item for approval at the May 2023 NYSPHSAA Executive Committee meeting. M. DiFilippo and M. Donahue were directed to express concern regarding the quality of the balls and to confirm that product pricing won't increase unreasonably during the term. *Please note: Section VI will receive no revenue share, no product, and no ball allotment for the 23-24 school year.

4.2 Football TV Contract

Section VI has contracted with Spectrum for football broadcasting rights for many years now. Spectrum has sole rights to broadcast Classes AA, A, and B Friday night football games. Recently, WNY Athletics approached Section VI proposing an agreement to broadcast via public broadcasting service across all classes and matching the revenue the Section receives from Spectrum. The benefits of the WNY Athletics proposal as compared to the Spectrum contract include more coverage of the student-athletes within Section VI, a greater availability (everyone has access to public broadcasting), equivalent revenue share, no opposition/restriction to other broadcasting agents. M. DiFilippo was directed to inquire with WNY Athletics about the options of a multi-year agreement and highlighting Section VI Athletics on a weekly basis. He was also asked to provide the proposed WNY Athletics contract and Spectrum contract to the committee to review and compare.

4.3 Mandatory AD Workshops/Makeups

The mandatory athletic director workshop, conducted by NYSPHSAA staff, is scheduled for August 16, 2023. The Executive Committee continued discussions about implementing another annual mandatory meeting in January. Implementing a second annual meeting stems from the need to further educate athletic directors and because of the significant amount of important content they are responsible for within the Section. In addition, athletic council member training, executive committee roles and responsibilities, strategies for leadership growth, athletic director monthly virtual meetings, and promotion of NYSAAA membership continue to be discussed.

4.4 Violation

On April 17, 2023. Iroquois self-reported to Section VI that their Varsity Baseball Coach did not sit-out the first game of the season as of result of his imposed suspension for violating the pitch count rule in the Spring 2022 season. Iroquois has cooperated with sitting the coach an additional game.

Safety Committee: Addition to NYSPHSAA Heat Index Regulation

X Action Item Discussion Item Informational Item
Presenter: Todd Nelson, NYSPHSAA Liaison to the Safety Committee
Proposal: The Safety Committee is recommending adding the Wet Bulb Temperature specific guidance (see attached) to the current NYSPHSAA Heat Index Regulation. The Safety Committee is also recommending adding the map which identifies the different categories to follow depending on the location of the site.
Effective Start Date: Immediately
Rationale: The committee was made aware that the current guidance and thresholds in the NYSPHSAA Heat Index regulations do not match up with the use of a Wet Bulb Temperature Indicator. The current thresholds are only good for heat index readings through WeatherBug. The recommended guidance and thresholds are specific to a Wet Bulb Temperature Indicator. The chart has three separate categories of recommendations. Category 1 and Category 2 are to be used for New York State. Most of the state is in Category 1.

Notes:

The Safety Committee feels this addition should be instituted immediately because of the liability some of our schools may in by using a Wet Bulb Temperature Indicator and using the current guidance chart for heat index.




Fig. 2. Heat safety regions.
