Tennis: Division II has the 7th team which will be moved down barring a tie next year.

Discussion of Jamestown being removed from alignment. Lock Jamestown for boys'/girls' basketball, wrestling, swimming, track. Wishing to return make a decision as to return. Court case stems from 1980 and Tyrone Beeman wishing to play basketball when Jamestown came to ECIC for competitive reasons.

Jamestown out of Division I can Sweet Home remain in Division II and Division I has only 6 teams. Based upon Constitution and no more than 1 difference between divisions, not able to have 6/8/7/7.

Alignment completed every 2 years, what happens if someone loses a team? How does this affect the alignment? Do the divisions get shuffled? Should it be 7/7/7/7 or leave as is at 6/8/7/7?

Should the activity board be able to just "push a school up" to balance the divisions when one or our ECIC teams removes from ECIC to play in another league because of competitiveness. Another non-competitive school put in a bad position.

Modified alignment: Softball currently there are 28 schools. Alignment completed based on 7/7/7/7 breakdown. 7/8/9 is intermingled between Division III and Division IV primarily due to with softball not quite sure if a team will be 7/8/9 or not due to a last-minute change. Baseball previously there were 30 teams, however, Jamestown dropped out, now 29 teams. West Seneca West, Iroquois moving up a division. Baseball has a 7/8/9 division and have been 7/8/9.

Options available for 7/8/9 softball which would mirror the baseball 7/8/9. Review and agree on an option. Baseball has separate division for 7/8/9. Should softball be separate division for 7/8/9. Modified teams in the same divisions due to traveling together.

All ECIC/Handbook Presentation Jason Lehmbeck, November AC Vote: Last review before vote.

Table of contents must be changed

- Page 2: Book mark in blue. Goes right to Section VI. Ease of use.
- Page 7: Red removed "HPER and" and inserted interscholastic athletics.
- **Page 10**: Section IV item 4-When no chairperson for sport a rotation of schools will take place of chairperson.
- Page 11: B. Divisional Alignment-(3) Divisional alignments are developed on an annual basis. Change this to a bi-annual basis. Also add an amendment "no team shall be permitted to withdraw from ECIC unless they are unable to field a team in which case rule (1) would not be required. Removal of teams, unable to field team, alignment every two (2) years. Alignment continues as is on an annual basis. Further discussion on bi-annual alignment.
- **Page 12: E. Postponed Contests:** substituting the word "may" be declared the loser instead of "shall" be declared the loser.
 - Page 14: Appeal Procedures: Use for issues pertaining to page 12, Postponed Contests.
 - **Page 15: Section II General Rules:**
- **(D) One Contest Per day:** added Multigame tournaments in volleyball constitute one contest.
- (F) **Notification of Results**: Appropriate website: Home schools shall submit....instead of "to the newspaper and "call in scores to the newspapers" which has been removed. No longer use newspapers.

- (I) **Awards**: Divisional patches will be the only awards provided.... instead of "will be provided" which has been removed. "trophies, plaques"... has been removed.
- **Page 16: Sports Standards**: Sports standards are reviewed by the Activity Board prior to each season. Groups should be assembled to review and make the next step of the task. This does not need to be written in the handbook. This will be removed. Sports standards should be reviewed by activity board for accuracy.
- **Page 19**: During Winter, February, and Spring Break, the athletic directors will be responsible for rescheduling athletic contests??? Is this clause still and accurate? This provision was put in place when Leanne Moore and Beth Fadeley were secretaries in the office. Should this wording be stricken from the hand book?
 - **Page 20**: (b) *regulations* removed and replaced with standards.
- (n) league central distribute in schedule star is still accurate removed and replaced with scheduling software
 - Page 21: (s) changed capital D to lower case d.
 - (t) added "and post to the ECIC website within 10 working days of meetings. Added job description of the new role for the new office staff
- **Page 22:** Change capital D to lower case d; post season removed; post season agenda sample removed. Should be as a directive and not request.
- **Page 26**: Appendix B (3) where possible all spectators areas are to be separated from player benches and the playing field (and/or court), added.
 - Page 27: added spectator code of conduct (signs) as part of bi-laws.

OT Modified FH example: Standards updates as of 2019, there is no overtime for field hockey. Thought as to possibly playing overtime. The standards need updating if overtime will be played. Niagara Orleans plays overtime in modified field hockey. If standards do not include

overtime and/or payment, standards must reflect this clause. Corrections to standards was always a season ahead for updates. Not every school capable of conducting overtime. Include in standards it is at the school's discretion. Overtime does not mean official receives more monies. What is procedure if official walks off due to overtime and same fee payment? Athletic directors assigned to a winter sport, contact the sport chairperson to review ECIC sports standards to be discussed further to be discussed at November meeting.
