• Start dates (Winter) 11/14/22 V/JV; 11/28/22 Modified; (spring) 3/13/23 V/JV; 3/20/223 Modified): Any school not wishing to start on these dates can modify their schedule accordingly. Global conversation about pushing back which resulted in determining your own schedule. Start 3/20 and 4/11 no play until 4/16. Create schedule, provide to schools and schools move on individual basis to accommodate practice requirement. Consider scheduling games later for fall.

Executive Director's Report:

Jim Graczyk

- Office Communications: Any needs? Nothing at this time
- Reminder when changing dates, times, contests to have a conversation with opposing school Athletic Office: Information should come from athletic director or secretary not through coach.
- Nominees Leadership positions current year positions available for President Elect: this position is to be filed by a non-athletic director. Vinny Dell'Oso president for the next (2) years and need president elect to follow after Vinny Dell'Oso. A non-athletic director includes a principal, superintendent, assistant principal, assistant superintendent, etc.

- Office Hiring: New secretary starts 11/14/2022 (3), Rachel Berent who will attend the September meeting.
- FALL '22/Any Concerns: Officials and scheduling. Move games to later in season for modified. Concern regarding league schedule ending (3) weeks before the end of the season to allow scheduling of non-league games.
- Charter Schools placement presentation 10/19/2022: Pat Burk (NFL), Jim Graczyk (ECIC) and Mike House from Buffalo Public Schools attended this meeting via phone. Charter schools not 100% ready to be a part of any league. Each section will send a representative to an advisory or ad hoc committee. The committee will make a recommendation on where to place charter schools within Section VI. Presentations lasted between 10-15 minutes each. Discussion in executive session lasted over one-hour. State association unhappy that the leagues in Section VI could not agree to a placement for charter schools and that the decision reverted to the state. Returned decision to Section VI to allow for more discussion before state has to make decision. Decision of placement of charter schools will be made in February 2023. Buffalo unable to include charter schools due to no facilities for games (charter schools no separate facilities), issues between BPS students and charter school students. If a charter school needs a facility, the BPS schools are used. Too much familiarity with each other. Violent issues could ensue. At state meeting in February a recommendation will be made regarding placement of charter schools. Originally there was interest by (8) charter schools to join a league and now the number is (3) charter schools wishing to be placed.
- League Directors Officials End of Season report October 26, 2022: Held a league director's meeting. Pat Burke, Mike House, Jim Graczyk, Al Gens, Jeff Roth (virtual) formulated ideas with information to be contained in an end of the season official's report. Information shared with athletic directors after completion.
- Golf Officials Paid 10/11/22: Golf officials paid \$100 each to officiate boys' ECIC golf championship. Decision made by Vinny Dell'Oso, Matt Adams and Jim Grazcyk. Currently no payment scale for golf officials. These officials volunteer and no payment is required. Officials are available for (5) hours off their own time without compensation.
- NYSAAA please complete application on Final Forms/ League paid all memberships: All memberships paid by ECIC for NYSAAA membership. Please complete the form and return to ECIC office. Email sent by NYSAAA with form. Fill form via email or NYSAAA website.
- Any schools volunteer for 3 person officials for any B&G Basketball contests: Round table held last week. Playoff will have 3 officials. Anyone interested in having a volunteer for a 3-person rotation on a game contact the ECIC office the information will be provided to the organizations. Just a suggestion, not a necessity. This procedure should not be allowed unless every game is covered with officials for every game.

Baseball/softball officials. Movement for teachers' certification of officiating modified games. Baseball definitely implementing a program of this nature. NYSPHSAA to send out information regarding this program.

Modified alignment decision regarding variations for softball how to place 7/8/9 for alignment. Last year softball 7/8/9 sporadic with 7/8. Baseball individual 7/8/9 division. Softball/baseball division for all 7/8/9 makes travel easier.

- **WINTER '22 Championship Swim**: Sweet Home & Alden, Dive; Maryvale, Wrestling; Sweet Home, Cheer; Sweet Home OR Amherst (date?), Bowling: Airport Lanes
- **JFK Modified 7/8/9 proposal:** Proposal relative to giving 9th grade athlete leeway to move up and down from modified to JV whenever the 9th grade athlete is needed to fill a position providing them with a 20-game season instead of a 14-game season. Proposal will need to go to section, the state. State meeting notes indicate voting for considering approving fifty (50%) percent of the season restrictions on promotion for 7th and 8th graders. Handbook committee did not support this consideration. One individual in favor from Section VII. Handbook committee with NYSPHSAA adamant about modified athletes moving up (7 & 8). APP not to fill rosters but for the elite athletes.
