

## ECIC BOYS SOCCER SPORTS STANDARDS

- I. Soccer in the ECIC shall be played according to the rules and regulations of the NYSPHSAA and those of the Commissioner of Education
- II. The National Federation Rule Book rules and regulations shall govern all ECIC games.
  - a. Home team must provide 4 corner flags
  - b. Goalies at all levels- Option of wearing soft protective headgear. EXP- Karate or boxing.
  - c. If a game is suspended before the half, the game shall be resumed from the point of interruption. If the game is suspended during 2<sup>nd</sup> half, the game stands as is.
- III. Winning team must report score to Buffalo News. Please make sure you have the accurate score available for them, (716) 849-4461. You should also **email news** to all league records to your division chairperson at the conclusion of each week.
- IV. Each game will consist of two- 40-minute halves. In case of a tie there will be 2 sudden victory overtimes lasting 10 minutes in length.
- V. Wherever possible, players benches and scorer's table should be on opposite side of the field across from the spectators, with no spectators allowed in bench area.
- VI. All coaches are required to input their team roster and schedule and report all game statistics to the Section VI boys soccer website.
