- ü Combing of Schools forms for Fall are Due! Looking for approval at January 18 Athletic Council Meeting.

### ü January vote on NYSPHSAA 6 classification proposal. Leagues should be prepared to vote.

- ü To be eligible for Sectional, intersectional or state competition, a team must have competed in six (6) school scheduled contests which occurred on six different dates during the regular season. An individual is eligible, if he/she has been an **eligible participant** on a team in that sport in that school for a minimum of six scheduled contests during the regular season.
- ü School districts may submit a written request to the Section office for adjustment of contests for individual participants based on medical documentation that confirms the individual was unable to participate in the required number of contests. Section VI Waiver Request Form:
