Rules:

Section VI Handbook plus league rules:

1. Each team will consist of 6 players but a team may play with fewer than 6. A match will consist of 9 holes of stroke play. A match will be considered complete if all players have finished the same 5 holes and is called due to weather. The scores from such a match will not be used in the calculation of that player's average.
2. The lowest 5 scores from each team will be used in calculating a score based on inverted cross country scoring.
3. In the event of a tie, add top 5 scores from each team-low total. If still tied, add top 6 scores and if still tied, use # 1 handicap hole and compare top 5 scores on that hole.
4. A dress code will be enforced for players and coaches. Shorts are allowable. No blue jeans or T-shirts allowed.
5. Cell phones and other electronic devices are to be turned off. Use is strictly prohibited.
6. All regular matches are to start no later than 4:00 PM.

Home Coach Duties

The duties of the home coach are to have an AED on site. Home coach is responsible for postponing a match prior to 2:00 PM and informing coaches and AD's of that postponement and subsequent make-up date. The home coach will make every attempt to report scores to local media.

Awards

CCAA all-stars both 1st and 2nd team

Division Chairperson Responsibilities:

1. Responsible for organization of League Qualifier
2. Prepare a schedule for the next season and submit to CCAA by April 15th or deadline as given
3. Contacting coaches and disseminating information about the Section VI tournament
4. Notify sectional representative of qualifiers for the Section VI tournament
5. Write an end-of-season report and submit to coaches and section rep.

League Qualifier Teams may send no more than 5 athletes to the league qualifier. Players should have no more than a 45 average. This is subject to change depending upon circumstances. The number of spots for the sections VI tournament is equal to the number of teams per league. Any player who qualified for the state tournament the prior year is exempt from the league qualifier but may play. This will not count as one of the spots.
