# Problems encountered/ concerns

The only area of concern was not being able to get the entire block of 6 courts from The Village Glen for the Sectional Tournament. I've already begun trying to fix this for next year. Eastside Racquet Club is again overcharging for court time (practice session).

# Recommendations for next season & proposed dates

- 1. We would like to hold our <u>Section 6 tournament</u> at either The Village Glen or Miller Tennis Center in Williamsville on October 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>. It is my goal to obtain a venue that can provide an entire block of courts for our tournament. Start times for both Friday and Saturday will be determined at a future date
- 2. The <u>State tournament</u> will be held November 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> in Syracuse. I have already secured a block of rooms (double beds) at the Embassy Suites for next year at a rate of 139.00 per room, with approval from Loren.
- 3. The league chairpersons would like the Team Championships to be part of the regular schedule that comes out in the spring. The schedule could indicate when the 1<sup>st</sup> round, 2<sup>nd</sup> round and 3<sup>rd</sup> round matches would be played. This would make transportation much easier to arrange for the visiting teams. I would be happy to work with whoever makes up the schedules for the ECIC and NFL to assure correct dates. We tried to get this done this year, but were not completely successful. Is there any possibility of starting our league matches earlier than Friday of the first week of school?
- 4. I would also strongly recommend some contingency plan be added to the current transportation to State Tournament policy. There may be a situation arise in which an athletes coach and parent are unable to drive them to Syracuse. A back-up plan should be placed in effect that would allow for travel and the athlete to participate in the tournament.
