The Section will need to fill the position of President-Elect for the 2022-2024 term. The postiiton will be posted in January and approval of the candidate will take place at the May Athletic Council meeting. Per the constitution, the candidate will be selected from the Central location (ECIC, Buffalo), which is next in the rotation.
