#### 100 Meter Dash & 200 Meter Dash


## Softball




state with a throw of 40'2.75". Maryam finished the season ranked #6 in New York State and #1 in WNY!

Reese Casinelli capped off his outstanding Track & Field career at Newfane by capturing the Boys, Division II, 400 Meter

Dash State Track Championship. His Lighting fast time of 47.99 is the 2nd fastest time ever run by a Section VI runner. This eclipsed his previous school record of 50.95 from last year and sets the new Niagara-Orleans League record. Reese's event flexibility throughout the season gave him the opportunity to choose his best path at the sectional meet. Leading up to the sectionals, he had qualifying times in the 100, 110 hurdles, 200, 400, 400 hurdles, 4x400 and 4x800.



With the help of his coaches, he decided to put all his focus into the 400 Dash and run the event fresh at sectionals. He captured his Sectional championship in the 400 Dash with a time of 49.12. This gave him a great seed at the State meet, facilitating his outstanding performance.
