#### Clymer/Sherman/Panama - Class D



The Clymer-Sherman-Panama (CSP) Wolfpack football team completed an undefeated season by capturing the New York State Class D State Championship with a 26-6 win against Section VII's Moriah. Finishing with an unblemished 13-0 record, CSP defeated perennial power Maple Grove three times, including a 35-7 victory in the Section VI Championship Game at New Era Field. The Wolfpack went on to defeat the #2 ranked teams in New York State in consecutive weeks—Section V's Alexander, 29-6, in the Far West Championship game, and Section IV's Tioga, 54-19, in the State Semifinals.

During the season, CSP scored 511 points while surrendering only 121. Offensively, the Wolfpack was led by Derek Ecklund's 1,753 all-purpose yards and 20 touchdowns. Michael Beatman accounted for 1,150 total yards and 14 touchdowns, while Cameron Barmore caught 46 passes for 966 yards and 12 touchdowns. Quarterback Gerrit Hinsdale broke multiple program records, completing 134 of 207 pass attempts for 2,038 yards and 23 touchdowns. Defensively, Robbie Overton, Steven Ryan and Beatman each made 77 tackles on the season, while Mitch Hovey had 12 sacks and John Swabik set a new program record with 6 interceptions. As a defensive unit, the Wolfpack forced 44 turnovers.

The program merged in 2015 and has improved every season.

# State Champions Girls Volleyball

#### Portville - Class C

For the second year in a row and the fifth time overall, the Portville Panthers volleyball team has earned the right to be crowned state champion.

Portville culminated a 42-2 season by defeating Section 9's Millbrook, in a 3-set sweep (25-10, 25-15, 25-23), never trailing in the match.

Portville's regular season was a portrait of dominance, as the Panthers rolled to a 24-0 overall record, a 12-0 league record, and losing only one league set.

In pool play at the state level, Portville logged a 6-0 record, earning the distinction of being the

only team in all classes and all Sections to come out of Saturday undefeated, vaulting them into the finals the following day.

In a season filled with stars and wonderful individual efforts, the list of honors is long and distinguished. CCAA All-Stars were Beth Miller (MVP), Sierra Keim, Ericka Carlson, Sydney Colligan, Kylie Blessing, Laura Wilhelm, Hailey Keim, Olivia Emley, and Reggie Tkacik. Miller, Sierra Keim, Carlson, and Colligan were also named to the NYS All-Star teams, and Miller and Sierra Keim both earned 1st Team All-Western New York. Finally, Beth Miller (MVP), Sierra Keim, and Kylie Blessing were named to the State All-Tournament Team. Beth Miller was also named the NYS Coaches' Association Section 6 Player of the Year. In the remarkable run the Panthers have enjoyed, the five seniors tallied up five Section 6 titles and four NYS titles. The Panthers return 10 letter winners for the 2019 campaign.




