For the second time in three years, the Section VI New York State Girls Gymnastics Team finished in 1st place winning another NYSPHSAA Championship on March 2, 2019 in Long Island! The Section VI team scored 187.905 points beating Section III (184.975), Section VIII (180.875), Section XI (179.65), Section I (175.725), Section II (173.425), Section V (172.45), PSAL (168.95), Section IX (158.15) and Section VII (152.375). The Section VI team score of 187.905 points broke the state team record of 186.776 points held by Section XI since 2003. Section VI also broke the state team Vault record with a score of 47.9, breaking the score of 47.625 set in 2015 by Section XI. Section VI continues to dominate Girls Gymnastics at the state level. This is the fifth state team championship for Section VI in the last eight years winning in 2012, 2014, 2016, 2017 & 2019. The team was comprised of nine gymnasts from four schools including Frontier, Lancaster, Williamsville North and Williamsville South.

A Section VI gymnast won a state championship in two of the four events and the all-around competition, along with the team championship. The victory was a combined team effort and all gymnasts competed unbelievably!

Leading the team with a strong performance was seventh-grade Frontier gymnast Lea Philarom. Philarom placed 1st in the All-Around competition with a score of 38.125. Philarom is the first seventh-grader in history from Section 6 to win the State All-Around Title. Philarom also placed 2nd on Beam (9.55), 2nd on Floor (9.525), 3rd on Bars (9.55) and 6th on Vault (9.50). Philarom has taken gymnastics to a new level at Frontier. She is an honor roll student and member of the Junior National Honor Society. At Frontier, Lea has made her way to the top of the charts breaking or tying all of the school gymnastics records. Vault 9.50 (T) Bars 9.55 (T) Beam 9.55 (T) Floor 9.525 AA 38.125. There is never an off season for the hardworking 13-year-old. When high school gymnastics is not in season, Lea continues her hard work. She competes as a USA Gymnastics Level 9 gymnast and recently qualified to compete in the Regional Championships. Lea is also a member of Frontier's track team.

Eighth-grader Reilly Gruttadauria and Eighth-grader Ava Shiff from Williamsville South also came away with State titles and had amazing performances. Gruttadauria won a State Championship on Vault with a score of 9.9. Gruttadauria's score of 9.9 on Vault set a new state record breaking the score of 9.85 set in 2013

& 2014 by Olivia O'Connor (Bay Shore- Section XI) & Rachel Filipski (Lancaster- Section VI). Shiff won a State Championship on Beam with a score of 9.6. Gruttadauria also placed 7th in the All-Around (37.05), 8th on Floor (9.2), 10th on Bars (9.10) and 16th on Beam (8.85). Shiff also placed 2nd in the All-Around (37.9), 4th on Floor (9.35), 5th on Vault (9.55) and 5th on Bars (9.4).

Other gymnasts with outstanding performances included:

Senior Captain Madison Penetrante from Williamsville North placed 2nd on Floor (9.525), 3rd on Vault (9.7), 8th on Beam (9.15), 12th on Bars (9.05), and 6th in the All-Around (37.425).

Ninth-grader Cali Czarcinski from Frontier placed 3rd on Beam (9.35), 9th on Bars (9.15), 15th on Floor (9.025), 18th on Vault (9.05) and 8th in

the All-Around (36.575).

Seventh-grader Kayla Gleason from Frontier placed 5th on Floor (9.3), 9th on Beam (9.1) and 11th on Vault (9.25).

Eleventh-grader Alison Wojciechowski from Lancaster placed 8th on Bars (9.2).

Supporting and cheering on their teammates were injured Senior Captain gymnasts Gabbi Gare from Williamsville South and Zoe Kyriakopoulos from Williamsville North. Gabbi was also awarded the NYSNPHSAA Sportsmanship Award.

The Dunkirk Lady Marauder Bowling team completed a historic season with a NYSPHSAA Small School - Division 2 State Championship. The ladies returned home from Syracuse to a police, fire, and fan escorted parade back to the high school where approximately 125 community members watched the girls ring the victory bell. The next morning, the girls were treated to breakfast at Bob Evans then on to a police escorted fire truck ride around the city, which went by all of our elementary, catholic, middle school and STEM school where students greeted us with cheers and signs. Back at the Dunkirk High School, we were welcomed by the students, faculty and staff by an assembly, at which the city's mayor declared it Lady Marauder - Women Month. This has only been part of the honors the ladies have received.

The ladies historic season consisted of the following: Champions at the Festival of Lights Tournament, 3rd at the Section VI Invitational, CCAA Division 1 Champions (39-1 record), CCAA County Roll-Off Tournament, Section VI Division 2 - Small School and Class C Champions, and NYSPHSAA Division 2 - Small School Champions. The 9 member team was also a NYS Scholar-Athlete team carrying a combined team GPA of 94.7. Rachel Glowniak led the team with a 1231 - 6 game total which was 2nd overall for the tournament. Makayla Pasierb had the 2nd high game of 246 and was 5th overall. Mariah Glowniak was 8th overall, Olivia Corbett was 13th and Hannah Ellman was 19th overall. Isabella Begier, Summer Clark, Whitney Hice, and Tayler Skelly rounded out our team.

This was the first girls team to win a State Championship at Dunkirk High School and was the first girls bowling team in Chautauqua County to win at the State Championships.

The Ten Broeck Academy and Franklinville Central School Girls Basketball team finished their season with a 21-5 record, and a New York State Class D Championship. After losing three key seniors from last year's team that lost by 3 points in overtime of the state

championship game, there were many unanswered questions about how they would fill those holes. Losing three of their first five games, the team was forced to redefine individual roles. This selfless group of girls did not care what it took to become successful. They all put what was best for the team ahead of their individual wants. It is for this main reason they were able to have such a successful season. After the slow start, the Lady Panthers went on to win twenty of their next twenty-two games, culminating in a state title.

Ellicottville Eagles win third consecutive State Championship!

The Ellicottville Girls Alpine Ski Team won the NYSPHSAA Alpine Skiing Team Championship for the third consecutive season this year at Gore Mountain Ski Resort, thanks to some top performances from sophomore twins Hayly and Logan Fredrickson.

This was led by Logan Fredrickson winning three individual titles (Slalom, Giant Slalom, Alpine Combined) she was backed up by the strong 5th and 7th place finishes from Hayly Fredrickson and the 29th place finish from CeCe Carls to give them the team title.

The team scores use top four results from a team's three skiers in the two events - Slalom and Giant Slalom. Ellicottville scored 92 points topping Pittford's (Section 5) score of 84.

In the slalom, Logan Fredrickson won her first individual State Championship with a 1st place combined time of 1:35.66, Hayly Fredrickson took 5th with a time of 1:43.56.

On the second day in the Giant Slalom, Logan Fredrickson finished 1st for her second individual State Championship with a combined time of 2:20.41 and with the two first place finishes this also makes Logan the Alpine Combined State Champion. Hayly Fredrickson took 7th with a time of 2:27.38 and CeCe Carls was 29th with a time of 2:34.96.

The Williamsville Girls Varsity Ice Hockey team made a historic skate to a NYSPHSAA Championship. The late January snowstorm that closed schools for three days also postponed the start of Sectionals. The delay meant if the Section VI Champion was going to win States, the team would have to win five elimination games over six days. Williamsville started the journey with a 7-1 quarterfinal win over Niagara County on Monday, February 4 and followed it up the next day with a hard fought 3-1 semifinal victory against Lancaster/Iroquois/Depew. The Section VI Championship on Wednesday, February 6 was a rematch of last year's final. Top-seeded and defending NYSPHSAA Champion Frontier/Lake Shore/Orchard Park (FLOP) vs. #2 Williamsville. After one period, FLOP looked to be on their way to a third straight Section VI title, owning a 2-0 lead. Emma Roland's two second period goals tied the game at 2 after 2. Early in the third period, FLOP regained the lead, 3-2. The game stayed that way thanks to some big saves by Williamsville Goalie Sydney Olschewske until midway through the third when Elizabeth Jackson tied it up setting the stage for a dramatic overtime finish. Two minutes and 40 seconds into overtime, Defenseman Erin Roland, Emma's twin sister, scored to give Williamsville its 1st Section VI Championship in the nine years of the program. Williamsville had been the runner-up in the final, a record four times before finally securing the coveted blue shields. Williamsville had little time to celebrate

with the NYSPHSAA semifinals looming 48 hours later. The win over FLOP gave Williamsville the energy needed to take on perennial state power Potsdam Friday, February 8 at HarborCenter. The hosts welcomed Potsdam to Buffalo with a resounding 6-1 win. Williamsville led 2-0 after two periods on goals by Junior Jenna Cavaleri and Emma Roland. Strong goaltending by Elizabeth Timby kept Potsdam off the scoreboard in the first 30 minutes. Williamsville then exploded for four goals in the third period, highlighted by Roland's hat trick, propelling them into the NYSPHSAA Championship against Section III Champion Skaneateles who won States in 2017. Williamsville never trailed in the final, but watched leads of 2-0 and 4-2 disappear. Eighth Grader Ella Huntley had the three-goal hat trick while Senior Defenseman Elisabeth Sidorski tallied as well. If Williamsville was going to follow up its 1st Sectional title with its 1st State title, it would also have to be in overtime. Williamsville completed a magical 6 days of playoff hockey. Cavaleri would be the hero, scoring the State Championship winning goal 3 minutes and 12 seconds into overtime with Emma Roland and Sidorski picking up assists. In some strange way, maybe the Blizzard of 2019 worked to Williamsville's advantage helping them win the required 5 games in 6 days. Williamsville finished the 2018-19 season with a 19-4-1 record.

300 Meters - Jada Kenner - Tapestry



Jada Kenner's first varsity track season turned out to be one of the most memorable ever. On her way to becoming the first Indoor Track and Field State Champion ever for Tapestry, Jada broke 4 state records for a 7th grader (55m, 60m, 200m, and 300m). Jada came into the state championship meet seeded 2nd and won with a personal best time of 39.24. She is believed to have become the youngest state champion ever at 12 years old. Not only is she a state champion, 2 days later she learned she had set a world age group record for a 12-year-old in the 300m. The previous record holder was Anna Kerbachova of the Czech Republic with a time of 40.19. She was also a part of the girls 4x200m (Alexis Johnson, Jada Kenner, Nyrelle Simpson, and Nia Stevens) that came into the meet seeded 11th and finished 6th in public schools and 8th overall in the State. Running a personal best and new Western New York record time of 1:44.36.

Leah had an outstanding Indoor Track season. She placed 2nd in the State in 2017, so you expected her to start off on top and just worry about herself improving. However, instead of racking up the wins, Leah had a difficult start to the season. Although she was placing 2nd in the meets, she wasn't near her peak performance. She worked hard all year and was a dedicated to the sport and to getting stronger in the weight room. Leah's first win of the season came on January 26th at a larger meeting in Rochester (Trent Walker/ Cedric Jackson Invite) with a height of 11' 6". As the season went on, Leah's jumps got better and better. She took 1st place at Team Championships, which helped her team to a Sectional Title and 2nd at the Sectional Championships. Leah was disappointed with the outcome at Sectionals, but knew that a State Title was the ultimate prize. At the State Meet, Leah had one of the best days competing, she broke her personal best height and won the title with a height of 13' 3". The following weekend, Leah competed at Indoor Nationals where she took 5th place.

30 Shot Standing Air Rifle - Team Clarence Individual Aggregate - Emily Gay

The Clarence Rifle team won the 30-shot standing sectionals on Saturday, February 16, 2019. The team was led by Senior Emily Gay who set two new sectional records that day. The other 4 members of the team were Junior Alexis Kirk, Junior Michael Dziabo, Sophomore Wyatt Belanger, and Freshman Adam Farolino.

On Saturday, March 3, 2019, the Clarence team won the 30-shot standing State Regional Rifle Match held at the USMA at West Point. The team upped its sectional score of 1122-41 centers by 14 points posting a score of 1136-37 centers. The team's score was just two points shy of tying the state record score of 1138-49 centers.

Again, Senior Emily Gay led the team posting a score of 291-14 centers out of a possible 300 points, four points higher than the next best score, and just 3 points shy of tying the state record score of 294-19 centers. Emily will be attending the USMA at West Point and hopes to compete for the Black Knights as a cadet.

Alexis Kirk finished 8th overall posting a score of 284; Wyatt Belanger finished 11th with a score of 281 and Michael Dziabo finished 12th with a score of 280. Adam Farolino, an alternate and non-scoring participant, posted a score of 281/300.

Alexis Kirk, Michael Dziabo, and Adam Farolino have also secured first round invitations to the National Junior Olympic Shooting

Sophomore Dylan Romance has been on Pioneer's rifle since its inaugural season three years ago. Dylan has set many team records and is a 3-time Sectional qualifier. This year he helped the Panthers win their first Sectional Championship in 3-position shooting.

At the regional tournament (held at the West Point Academy) Dylan led the team to a second place finish shooting a 292, which was tied for the highest total in the competition. He capped the day off by winning the state title in kneeling, shooting a 98 target.

Division II, 160 lbs. - Cory Day - Iroquois



Iroquois Senior Cory Day accomplished his vision quest as he captured first place in the NY State Wrestling Championship in Division II at the 160 lbs. category. Along with wrestling, he is a three-sport athlete and League All-Star in both football and baseball. Cory closes out his Iroquois wrestling career with 237 wins and 138 pins; 4 class championships; 3 Sectional championships; numerous tournament first-place finishes, and a fourth place finish in the State Championships in his junior year. He is a ninety plus student in the classroom, involved in Student Government, and an outstanding leader in his role of team captain for his many sports. Presently, Cory is undecided as to what sport he would like to continue with in college.



Division II, 220 lbs. - Mike Rigerman - Pioneer

Mike Rigerman further cemented his place as one of Pioneer's most successful athletes by adding a state wrestling championship. At the 2018-2019 state meet in Albany, Mike fought his way to the Division II title at 220 lbs., dominating opponents in the same manner as he did on the football field en route to the Connolly Cup (top player in Western New York). Mike recently committed to continue his football career at Division II Findlay University of Ohio. Mike is Pioneer's 6th state champion and finished 43-0 in his senior year of wrestling. According to WNY Athletics, Mike earned pins in the first two rounds to advance to the semis. He met the 4th seeded



Jeff Crooks (Cobleskill-Richmondville HS of Section 2) and battled to a 5-2 decision to advance to the final. In the final, Mike would meet another returning state place-winner in 2nd seeded Keagan Carmenatty from South Seneca HS (Section 5). Mike hung on against a tough opponent for a 5-3 victory. Mike credited his team, coaches and the Pioneer community for helping fuel his race to the top. Mike joins Ron Tojdowski (1969), Keith Stearns (1975), Kyle Grunwald (1976, 1977), Kyle Colling (2009, 2010), and Tony Lock (2012) as Pioneer state champions in wrestling.

Division II, 195 lbs. - Robbie Penhollow - Falconer/Cassadaga Valley



Robbie had an outstanding wrestling career at Falconer. He finished his career with a 167-31 record. During his senior year, he finished with a 49-1 record while accumulating 31 pins. His greatest accomplishment was winning the New York State title at 195 pounds this season. Robbie capped off his wrestling career with a 9-5 win at the Dapper Dan All Star Wrestling Classic in Pittsburgh on March 15th.

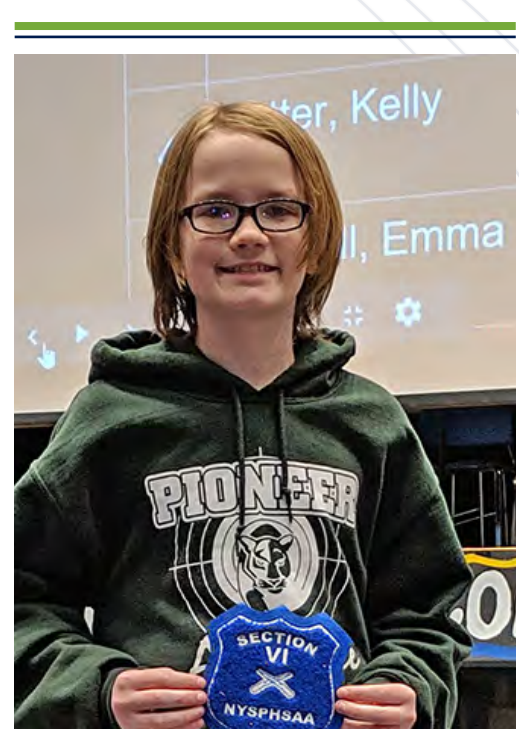

Winter Scholar-Athletes

This is the 27th year the NYSPHSAA has conducted the Scholar-Athlete program, which is sponsored by Pupil Benefits Plan, Inc.

A total of 633 NYSPHSAA member schools submitted Scholar-Athlete information this season. To qualify as a Scholar-Athlete team, 75% of the team roster's averaged GPA must be 90.0 or above. This winter, 2,616 teams earned the Scholar-Athlete team award. The number of Scholar-Athlete teams increased by 10.1% compared to the winter of 2018.

To be named a Scholar-Athlete individual, a student must earn an individual GPA of 90.0 or above regardless of their team earning Scholar-Athlete team status. A record-high 33,275 students achieved this milestone in the winter. This year, the number of Scholar-Athlete individual winners increased by 7.09% compared to the winter 2018 season.

"The Scholar-Athlete program is our most successful student program," said Dr. Robert Zayas, NYSPHSAA Executive Director. "The continued increase shows the dedication schools, athletic departments, teams, coaches, and most importantly, student-athletes have towards academics. We could not be more proud to recognize these hard-working teams and individuals that are committed to their education."

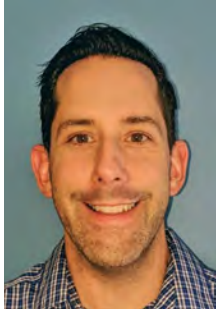
