- 4.1 Section VI Budget 2009-10:
 - The full-time Executive Director position is fully funded in the budget. \$30,000 of the salary and 100% of the benefits will qualify for BOCES aid.
 - Section VI member dues will increase to support the position. The per-sport fee will increase from \$95 to \$120. The classification fees will increase as follows: AA +\$200, A +\$195, B +\$180, C +\$170, D +\$165. The dues increase will be offset by a rebate to member schools from the Fund Balance in 2009-10 and by BOCES aid in subsequent years.
 - A three –year financial plan is still needed and will be developed by the Finance Committee.
