- 1.0 Fund Balance review: At the present time the Fund Balance lies between the required 40% and 60%.
- 2.0 The Section VI Budget for 2009-10 was discussed line-by-line. Changes are reflected in the proposed budget will be presented at the November meeting:
 - 2.1 Section Budget discussed at length:
 - Sportchair stipends-Should sportchairs receive an increase in their stipends for all their responsibilities? Stipend line item was increased substantially from \$7,500 to \$13,500.
 - Office salaries- It was decided that the salaries for the Executive Secretary, Treasurer and Officials Coordinator be left blank due to the uncertainty of the duties of the Executive Director position and whether the positions of Treasurer and Officials Coordinator would still exist.
 - Centralized Management of Officials and costs for TheArbiter: The following questions were raised:
 - Should the assigner fee, \$25 per assigner, be passed on to the respective league or officials organization?
 - > Should Monsignor Martin be charged for their usage?
 - Should any cost be passed on to officials? This would be contractual new contract negotiations begin on January 2009
 - 2.2 Sports Budgets: not discussed
- 3.0 The Annual Audit by Gaines, Kriner and Elliott will be done at the end of October or beginning of November.
