- 4.1 Officials Coordination Central Management/Assigning of Officials: Winter Sectional assignments were all posted on ArbiterSports. Payment of officials assigned in ArbiterSports using RefPay was completed for Boys Ice Hockey. The use of RefPay was beneficial for all involved and the response was positive. The Section is moving forward with this method of payment for Boys and Girls Lacrosse officials for sectional semis and finals.
