6.1 FinanceCommittee - April Report/Minutes

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed. The finances for winter sports are complete and Winter Sports

Financial Reports are posted. Action was taken on the following items based on recommendations from the Finance Committee:

a) Reimbursement Formula: Approximately \$48,000 is available for reimbursement to schools attending state competition in 2010-11. *Motion to approve distribution of funds from the Benefits to Districts Account in 2010-11 to districts as a reimbursement for travel to state competition as follows* CARRIED Dunnigan/Wendt:

\$500.00 per team for travel to finals

\$250.00 per team for additional travel to semi-finals (football, boys lacrosse)

\$30.00 per individual competing at states

b) Individual sports*/Dedicated fund: The payment process for state competition in individual sports is not cost effective. The Section pays expenses, bills the districts for their athletes' participation each season, then reimburses districts as per the established formula (item a above) at the end of the year. Also, invoices issued to districts are not timely, causing concerns for district business offices. A dedicated fund within the Fund Balance for direct payment of expenses for state competition in individual sports would relieve the districts of this financial responsibility and streamline the process for all. With the Section assuming the financial responsibility for individual sports in this manner, there would be no reimbursement to districts for state competition for team sports. Districts would continue to receive mileage reimbursement from the state for team sports. Motion to approve the establishment of a Dedicated Fund to cover costs for state competition (instead of issuing a reimbursement) for individual sports* when transportation is provided as per the Travel Policy and discontinue the reimbursement for team sports on a trial basis for two years CARRIED Stedman/Graczyk

*The Individual sports included in the Dedicated Fund are those sports for which Section VI transportation is provided (Group 2 in the Travel Policy)
