#### Sportsmanship: 4.1

- a) When coaches do not fulfill the penalty of the Sportsmanship Regulation during the regular season and sectional competition, the Section will impose a penalty on the coach/school. During regional/ state competition, the NYSPHSAA Exec, Director will impose the penalty. For approval at the State level: the coach will sit-out the next two regularly scheduled contests
- b) Section VI Soccer Sportsmanship Policy regarding red and yellow cards: The Boys Soccer Committee requested that Section VI use the state policy. T.Slade met with the boys and girls soccer chairs and it was agreed that the more stringent Section VI policy will continue to be used.
- 4.2 Officials Coordination
  - a) Officials Contract Negotiations: T.Cowan will review the Highlights of the Tentative Agreement at the Athletic Council meeting and will ask for approval. The final document incorporating the Highlights is being re-written and will be on the agenda for formal approval at the May AC meeting. - b) Superintendent and Business Manager reps on the Finance committee advised against a dues reduction as the means of reimbursing districts since dues receive BOCES aid.   - a) <u>Principal's Rep position</u>: The Section was unable to nominate an individual for the NYSPHSAA 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President position since the nominee must be a principals rep for the section. J.Dunnigan, the only Principals Rep in the Section, was not interested in the position. When Mr. Dunnigan retires, his replacement should be a person who currently serves as a Principals Rep. Superintendents and Principals polled were in favor of a return of the Principal's Rep position to the Athletic Council. An ACTION ITEM for AC will be to approve the reinstatement of the Principals Representative position from each league on the Athletic Council.
  - b) <u>Championship Philosophy issues</u> were addressed at a meeting March 22. Recommendations for the May AC meeting include requiring a minimum of 18 schools in a division for a split, allowing no changes to the seeding after the seeding meeting, denying requests to move up a class and approving a 5-class tournament for wrestling. If districts budgets fail, schools may need to combine athletic programs after the Section's May deadline for these requests. The Section VI Philosophy emphasizes that our mission is to *meet the needs of all students*. Athletic Council members, sportchairs, assigners and officials will need to be flexible and understanding. Communication between ADs, their league and the Section regarding programs affected by budget status is critical. These concerns will be discussed with the Athletic Council.
- 8.2 The Central Committee meeting is Aug.3-5 at Holiday Valley. Mark Ward, Ellicottville, will be inaugurated as the NYSPHSAA President. T. Slade will meet with M.Ward later today and contact N. Van Erk regarding plans made to date for the golf outing, activities in the area, gift bags, etc. T.Slade will contact the Chambers of Commerce/ Visitors Bureau in Ellicottville. D.Munro and M.Wendt offered to work on the Summer Meeting Committee. A report will be given at the next Executive Committee meeting in April.
