Rationale:

In Division 1, the largest of the Class divisions is due to be the smallest division next season. This year there were 14 - 4A schools as opposed to 12 - 3A schools. If we stay at 23 Division 1 schools, we can rotate every other season; 11 and 12 schools).

Due to the new BEDS numbers, Section 6 will have 3 more Division 2 schools than 2009-2010 in the sport of wrestling. 40 (D2) schools creates a problem in finding sites large enough to host a 20 school wrestling tournament. If we have 3 classifications within D2, we can hold tournaments that are more manageable in size with 13 schools in Class B, 13 schools in class C and 14 schools in Class D (Overall, 3 - D2 Class tournaments).

Qualifying for the Section 6 Wrestling Championships

Division 1

The top 5 place finishers from the divisional tournaments will qualify for the Sectional Championships. The Sectional Championship tournament will start with a ten man bracket. In round 1, the tenth seed will wrestle against the 7^{th} seed and the 9^{th} seed will wrestle the 8^{th} seed. The two losers from those bouts will be eliminated from the tournament. Wrestle-back matches will begin with the losers from the round of 8 (as we currently do). This format will add 30 bouts to the current format (30 bouts @ \$6.00 = \$180.00)

Division 2

The top 4 place finishers from the 3 Divisional tournaments will qualify for the Sectional Championships. We will start with a 12 man bracket. The losers of round 1 will be eliminated from the tournament (four wrestlers per weight class). Wrestle-back matches will begin with the losers from the round of 8 (as we currently do). This format will add 60 bouts to the current format (60 bouts @ \$6.00 = \$360.00.

Rationale:

The committee would like to make sure that the best wrestlers from the Section are qualifying for the Sectional Championships. From year to year, and from weight class to weight class, we feel that the top 8 wrestlers are not always qualifying for the Sectional Championships. For example, the 5th place finisher from the class AA tournament could be better than the 3rd or 4th place finisher from the Class A tournament (or vice versa). In Division 1, adding one additional place finisher from each of the two class tournaments as a qualifier to the Sectional Championship tournament helps to ensure that the best wrestlers are indeed qualifying.

In Division 2, the same holds true (as far as our ultimate goal of qualifying the best to the Sectional Championships). However, the wrestling committee feels very strongly about holding a Sectional Championship tournament that can be completed in one day of competition. If we qualify 4 wrestlers from each of the 3 Class/Divisional tournaments to the Sectional Championships, with the opening round being an elimination round, we can still run a one day tournament within a reasonable time frame.

Both D1 and D2 tournaments will be completed in one day on 4 mats. If necessary, to expedite things, a 5th mat may be used for the first round of the Division 2 tournament. The time schedule will have to be adjusted slightly for both Divisions. Our current site for the Sectional Championships would easily be able to put down an additional mat if required.
