Subject: Finance Committee recommendation to change the financial operation for Sectional Pre-Quarter Final games for 2010-2011.

As Section 6 Boys Basketball Chairman I respectfully ask the Athletic Council to consider the following:

1. These games are Section 6 games, not individual school games.

- 2. The admission charge for these games of \$3.00 has been the same for at least the last 20 years.
- 3. If this policy had been in place for the 2009-2010 season the cost to Athletic Departments of the hosting individual districts would have been \$14,321.00. This amounts to an average of almost \$500.00 per district.
- 4. This \$14,321.00 will be paid out of Athletic Budgets. Any gate receipts will be credited to the Districts General Fund and never seen by Athletic Departments.
- 5. This policy change gives the appearance that Section 6 wants to take responsibility when there is money to be made but when there is any deficit involved the individual district should bear the burden.
- 6. The Section lost \$1,846.00 on these games in 2009-2010.but realized a profit of \$38,042.05 overall. The question is, who can best afford these games, Section 6 or Individual Districts who are already struggling with tight budgets.
- 7. Will this discourage participation by some schools because of the cost, thereby denying another game to an already shorten schedule, to our student/athletes? I believe that it will.

Again, as Section 6 Boys Basketball Chairman, I respectfully recommend that the Athletic Council reject this recommendation of the Finance Committee.
