- 1.0 Wrestling Weight Certification: The dates for weight certification were confirmed as Lockport Nov.13, Cheektowaga Nov. 14, Fredonia Nov.15, Olean Nov.16. The Section's expectation from coaches at each site was reviewed.
- 2.0 Charter Schools: The following was discussed:
  - 2.1 A Charter School's classification is based on BEDS Numbers.
  - 2.2 Charter Schools do not have to play in a league. They may play all non-league games, which would be scored for power points for post season playoffs.
- 3.0 7- Day Rule:
  - 3.1 Lightning: A game suspended because of lightning is not affected by the 7-day rule.
  - 3.2 Protest: A game under protest is affected by the 7-day rule.
- 4.0 The Indoor Track Committee will use the following procedure for 2007-08 to prevent violations of Selection Classification:

Pre-season:

- a) A roster will be turned in to the Section office on or before the Tuesday prior to a school's first competition. The roster will include athlete's name, grade, male or female, date of birth and date of entry to 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Rosters must be signed by Coach, AD, and Principal.
- b) Notification of Classification (Selection Classification Roster), including last year's 7<sup>th</sup> graders who passed the test, must be turned in to the Section office on or before the Tuesday prior to a schools first competition.

In Season:

- a) Additions to team rosters or SC rosters must be turned in to the Section office on or before the Tuesday prior to a school's next competition.
- b) Athletes' entry cards must be filled out completely using the agreed upon colors. Blue for boys and pink for girls.
- c) Athletes/Teams will not be eligible to compete if above deadlines are not followed.
- 5.0 Wrestling Management: All schools hosting Wrestling Tournaments are to restrict uncertified coaches from the mat/floor space. Coaches need to help in this effort to preserve the safety of the competitors.
- 6.0 Received Post Season Reports:
  - Boys Tennis
  - Boys Lacrosse
  - Girls Lacrosse
  - Track
  - Boys Golf

NOT RECEIVED in time for review at the meeting: Baseball, Softball, Girls Golf

7.0 Seneca's Boys Basketball: Seneca High School consists of only grade 12 in 2007-08 and will close next year. As a result, BEDS numbers classify Seneca as a D school for 07-08. Dave Thomas, Buffalo AD, was informed that a written request must be submitted to the Section office to pursue approval for Seneca to compete in a different class.
