- 1.0 Issue of school changes to contests within 7 days of the contest (Officials Contract pp.8-11)

- 2.0 Wrestling:
 - 2.1 **Proposed Wrestling Tournament Guidelines** (attached*)
Wrestling proposed a management system to control the floor area at Wrestling Tournaments. We believe that members of the Wrestling Committee will work to eliminate the issues created by uncertified personal in the wrestler's area. We also believe that education of coaches on this issue at local tournaments will be a solid start for the change. The committee recommends sending two passes to the AD for the certified coaches allowed on the floor matside.
 - 2.2 Dates for Weight Certification: 11/13, 14, 15 & 16.
- 3.0 Indoor Track - Selection Classification concern from 2006-07 season:
 - 3.1 Not all schools have submitted their SC report as requested.
 - 3.2 Indoor track will monitor the athletes under 9th grade by hiring an individual to check every middle school athlete for proper S/C documentation. Athletes lacking approval will be sent home and the School Superintendent notified.
- 4.0 **Girls Swim – In Season State Qualifying Procedure** (attached*) **APPROVED AC 9/19/07 item 10.9**
Girls Swimming proposal mirrors the boys program now in place which worked well. The committee recommends approval.
- 5.0 The practice of playing up a classification was referred to the Sectional/Intersectional committee for review. (Executive Committee 8/1/07 item 5.3) the Sec/ Inter Committee was very displeased with the fact that City Honors was allowed to change Class C to B without review by the Committee. Schools have been denied in the past and this type of movement could follow a movement to get away from competition.
