- Section 6 took over t-shirt sales.
- Opt Out Policy & 9th game procedures were changed.
- There was a DD Division used this year which seemed to provide a very competitive season of football for these schools.

Problems encountered/ concerns:

- The revised Opt-Out Policy made it very difficult to schedule 9th games for every school. Coaches are unable to scout opponents and some schools are left without games.

- The federation would like to create or revise the current website to include rosters, schedules, etc...
- The Federation has a concern over Section VI passes being used at RWS. The concern is over the impact on our proceeds.
