**Report on changes in Policy or Practice that were implemented**

B.Kowal: Positives:

- Timm Slade and the Sectional Intersectional Committee/ AC allowed us to split the A's and B's and it was a tremendous success.
- Having Section VI provide the collecting of money is a great idea.
- Rohn Pierce and Zach Lauricella on earning Division 1 scholarships to Canisius and St. John's.

J.Conley: Splitting Class A and Class B into A1, A2, B1,B2 allowed for better competition and most coaches were happy with that decision.

**Problems encountered/ concerns** Concern(s):

B.Kowal:

- The Committee needs new blood. The same people do the same jobs every year. The Committee welcomes and needs help. Bob Burnside, Bob Barrows, Gary Mannella, Bill Steadman, and Jim Conley are all retired.
- I do think it is beneficial that the Chairman should if possible be retired. It was very difficult this season due to rain and other factors to teach social studies, be co-Department Chairman, ECIC Division Chairman, and coach. It was not unusual to get 10 calls in a day. With the State implementation of AAPR standards, all current teachers might not have the time to be Chairman.
- Disappointment that no Section VI team won a State Championship in my four years, a poor 1-4 record in regional games this year, even though every squad had their best pitcher ready.
- Finally, I was dismayed by the reaction of the Victor assistant coaches and fans when they were caught using an illegal bat. The Section V representative present was tremendous and agreed with the decision, but being called a cheater, and numerous other things not printable by a team that was using something illegal was not appreciated.
- A duplication of medical services is costly and not needed, in the Regional game both Clarence and Section VI had trainers present. In these cost cutting times, the cost of trainers should be discussed.

J.Conley: Committee members heard many complaints about the location of some of the games concerning travel to and from the games. The problem is we do not have enough choices of playing fields at our disposal.

**Report on changes in Policy or Practice that were implemented**

Girls lacrosse was federated and divided into three divisions. Division 1 was A schools, D-2, B schools and D-3, C schools. Due to the amount of teams in each division, A schools played each team twice, leaving only four non-league games, making it difficult to arrange games with teams outside our area. - Tie-breaker proposal is being reviewed, similar to Boys lacrosse, as well as investigating division alignments and power rating procedures. EG: Section V uses Laxpower rating system in which all games count.
- Creating a schedule that provides better opportunity to play non-league games during the season by not playing consecutive division games, as well as creating a playoff schedule with less time between games.
