From State Softball Committee meeting on November 10, 2009 via teleconference

- 1. Report from State Tournament in Waterloo, NY, Section V
 - Plans for the 2010 tournament will begin the week of Nov. 23rd
 - Original brackets will change as the Class D games will be played on the lower fields
 - Regional Games for Section 6 will be held at the following sites:
 Class AA, A, & B- Niagara Falls HS 2:00, 4:00, & 6:00 games
 Class C & D will be held at Section V Scio HS 4:00 & 6:00
 - Regional code of conduct has been changed-teams participating can use the old one for one year. Revision is located on the web site
 - All coaches, players, trainers, and supervisors must have a signed code of conduct for Regional games. Host schools should have extra copies available
 - AED Provision & NYSPHSAA Regional/Championships Emergency Preparedness and Crowd Control sheet must be sent in
 - Senior All-Star contest concerns-players will be ineligible if they participate in all-star game before the end of sectional, regional or state play
 - <u>Definition of a scrimmage</u>- a great deal of discussion took place on this issue. Many ideas were discussed and the following was decided. Three of the following must take place in order for a contest to be considered a scrimmage:
 - No line up card exchanged between teams
 - No score will be kept

One of the following three options must take place:

- o 6 outs, clear the bases after 3 outs
- o everyone on the roster must bat in the lineup
- place a runner on a base during even innings while odd innings can be played straight up
- Modified softball proposal
 - o 3 outs or 5 runs will end the inning for innings 1-6
 - o 3 outs and no run limit on inning 7
 - NO TIME LIMIT on the game
- Section 11 adopted a mandatory helmet rule for coaches
 - o Section 8 is in discussion about the same rule
- Pitching distance will stay at 40 feet- Federation did go to 43 feet. There is a possibility that teams can experiment with the 43 ft distance in non-league games and/or tournaments this season
- January 29, 2010 NYS Softball coaches clinic will be held at the Filed of Dreams in Utica, NY-information will be sent and also posted on website
- Next Meeting will be held on June 11, 2010 @ the Holiday Inn, Waterloo, NY with a 12:30 start time
