

The schedule could indicate when the 1st round, 2nd round and 3rd round matches would be played. This would make transportation much easier to arrange for the visiting teams. I would be happy to work with whoever makes up the schedules for the ECIC and NFL to assure correct dates. We tried to get this done this year, but were not completely successful.
3. I would also strongly recommend some contingency plan be added to the current transportation to State Tournament policy.
