Report on changes in Policy or Practice that were implemented:

We're looking into the possibility of hosting the Section VI State Qualifier Championships at RIT in Section V during the 2011 Indoor Season. Further Details will be given to Timm Slade down the road.

Problems encountered/ concerns:

- The Indoor Track & Field Conduct Expectations that all coaches get from the beginning of the season to read to all their athletes will now also be given to all of the Athletic Directors.
- We will need to notify Buffalo State and especially Fredonia State that their cleaning staff will need to empty the garbage cans more often.
- Sound System at Fredonia State wasn't working that well at the State Qualifier Championships. This cannot happen since this is our 'Biggest Meet' of the Year!! I will let Fredonia State know of this situation and have them make sure that they check their system on a regular basis.
- The Finishing Line Officials at the State Qualifier Championships unfortunately made a huge mistake in the Girls 3,000 Meter Run. They missed counted the number of laps, having all girls run one less lap.

Recommendations for next season:

- Jim Zubler from Frontier High School has decided to step down as one of the Indoor Track & Field Committee Members. There is too much on his plate between X-Country, Outdoor and his Summer Program. Hence, Brian Lombardo from Sweet Home was elected as the 'New' representative to take over Jim Zubler's responsibilities. Also, since Jim Zubler was a voting member for the ECIC, Kevin Carriero will now be the 'New' voting member for the ECIC.
- We're looking at adding the Distance Medley Relay & Sprint Medley Relay at Buffalo State College for the early part of the season only. This would replace the 4 x 800 and/or 4 x 400 Meter Relay. We're just trying to make the early part of the season a little bit different.
- As of right now, we are having all girls going off the 8' board in the Long Jump. We have decided that any girl who meets the Sectional Standard in the Long Jump will be allowed to jump off either board (8' or 12' board). This is not an issue for the boys.
- Because of the official's mistake in the Girls 3,000 Meter Run at the State Qualifier Championships, we will now institute a Coaches Box on the floor for those teams that have an athlete involved in that event for both the 3,000 and 3,200 Meter runs. This will help the officials and vice-versa. Note: The Finishing Line Officials would have final say.
- Also, we are going to assign a committee member to help with the officials at the Team and State Qualifier Championships in all Field Events.
- Scoring at the Team Challenge and the Team Championships will now be scored in terms of Large/Small Schools.

Other pertinent data:

We're looking into the possibility of hosting the Section VI State Qualifier Championships at RIT (8 lane 200 meter track) in Section V during the 2011 Indoor Season. It is a better facility and a faster track for our athletes. Further Details will be given to Timm Slade down the road. RIT is the same distance for the majority of the teams in the northern part of the section. We are also inquiring with RIT regarding costs/fees for the event. The only concern will be officials. If RIT is in Section 5 would the officials need to be Section 5 officials?
